

purchase and receive one or more of said books, the chairman of said board, together with the county clerk, shall sign a warrant of the county in an amount equal to the price agreed to be paid for said books, and shall deliver the same on demand to the publisher.

§ 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage and approval.

**Note by the Secretary of the Territory.**

The foregoing act, having been presented to the Governor for his approval, and not having been returned to the House of Representatives, the House of the Legislative Assembly in which it originated, within the time prescribed by the Organic Act, has become a law without his approval.

## Legal Holidays.

### CHAPTER 88.

AN ACT to Amend Section Twenty one Hundred and Fifteen of the Civil Code of the Territory of Dakota.

*Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Dakota :*

§ 1. DECORATION DAY.] That section twenty-one hundred and fifteen of the Civil Code, be and the same is hereby amended by inserting after the word "December," in the third line of said section, the following words: "The thirtieth day of May."

§ 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
