§ 2. All acts and parts of acts in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

§ 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.

License Funds.

CHAPTER 111.

AN ACT to amend Section 53 of Chapter 44 of the laws of 1883, and to provide what Fund, money paid to the County Treasurer for Licenses to sell Intoxicating liquors, shall be applied.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Dakota :

§ 1. LICENSE FUNDS WITHDRAWN FROM PUBLIC SCHOOLS.] That section 53 of chapter 44, of the laws of 1883, be, and the same is hereby amended by striking out the words: "And all money paid into the county treasury for license to sell intoxicating liquors."

§ 2. PAID TO GENERAL COUNTY FUND.] All fines, forfeitures and pecuniary penalties prescribed as a punishment for crime and collected under the general laws of the Territory: and all money paid into the county treasury for license to sell intoxicating liquors in the various counties, shall be placed in and become a part of the general county fund.

§ 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 15, 1885.
