## CHAPTER 5.

JOINT RESOLUTION Providing for the Printing of the Report of the Regents of Brookings Agricultural College.

*Be it resolved by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Dakota:*

PROVIDING FOR PRINTING REPORTS.] That the regents of Brookings Agricultural College, be and they are hereby authorized to procure the printing of five hundred copies of the report of said regents, and that a sufficient sum of money is hereby appropriated to pay for the same out of any money in the territorial treasury not otherwise appropriated.

## Aid to Sufferers by Storms.

## CHAPTER 6.

AN ACT to Authorize the County Commissioners of Minnehaha, Lake, Miner and Kingsbury, Faulk, Hyde, Richland, Beadle, Sully, Aurora and Potter Counties to aid certain Persons whose Crops were Destroyed by Storms.

*Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Dakota:*

§ 1. COMMISSIONERS OF CERTAIN COUNTIES EMPOWERED TO EXTEND AID.] That the board of county commissioners of Minnehaha, Miner, Lake, Kingsbury, Faulk, Hyde, Richland, Beadle, Sully, Aurora and Potter counties are hereby authorized to lend the credit of said counties, or aid by donation in money or seed grain, to such persons as had their crops destroyed by storms in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-four. Said board of commissioners shall use their discretion, and after a careful investigation extend such aid only to such persons as are in great need of assistance.

§ 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
