
The time specified in the summons for the appearance of the defendant shall in all cases be not less than three nor more than twelve days from the date of the service of the same."

§ 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 140.

AN ACT Amending Chapter (10) Ten of the Political Code.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Dakota:

§ 1. **THREE TERMS ANNUALLY.]** That chapter ten (10) of the Political Code be amended so as to read as follows: "Chapter ten—terms of supreme court—three terms annually." There shall be held three terms annually of the supreme court, as follows: One term at Bismarck commencing on the first Tuesday of February, one term at Yankton commencing on the second Tuesday of May and one term at Deadwood commencing on the first Tuesday of October.

§ 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
