ADULTERATION OF CANDY.

AN ACT to Prevent the Adulteration of Candy.

Be it Enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of North Dakota:

§ 1. ADULTERATION UNLAWFUL.] No person shall by himself, his servant, or agent, or as the servant or agent of any other person or corporation, manufacture for sale, or knowingly sell or offer to sell any candy adulterated by the admixture of terra alba, barytes, talc, or any other mineral substance, by poisonous colors or flavors or other ingredients deleterious or detrimental to health.

§ 2. PENALTY.] Whoever violates any of the provisions of this act shall be punished by a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars (\$100.00) nor less than fifty dollars (\$50.00). The candy so adulterated shall be forfeited and destroyed under direction of the court.

§ 3. EMERGENCY.] An emergency existing in that there is now no provision of law to prevent the sale or manufacture of adulterated candies; *Therefore*, this act shall take effect from and after its passage and approval.

AGE OF CONSENT.

AN ACT to Amend Section 2721 of the Revised Codes, Relating to Age of Consent to Marriage.

Be it Enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of North Dakota:

§ 1. AMENDMENT.] That section 2721, of the Revised Codes of North Dakota, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:
