STATE PRINTING AND BINDING.

AN ACT to Amend Section 76 of the Revised Codes of North Dakota, Relating to Accounts for Printing and Binding Required by State Officers and Making an Annual Appropriation Therefor.

Be it Enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of North Dakota:

§ 1. AMENDMENT.] That section 76 of the Revised Codes of North Dakota be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

§ 76. PRINTING ACCOUNTS TO BE APPROVED—APPROPRIATION FOR.] All accounts for printing and binding required by the Governor and other state officials, and for such printing and binding as may be authorized by the legislative assembly shall be certified to according to law, and when such accounts shall have been approved in writing by the Secretary of State, whose duty it shall be to keep a record of and carefully examine all printing so authorized; the State Auditor shall draw his warrant on the State Treasurer for such sums as may be found due, and there is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated a sum sufficient to pay for said printing; *Provided*, that the total sum to be expended under the provisions of this section shall not exceed the sum of ten thousand dollars per annum.
