REFUNDING TO CERTAIN COUNTIES.

AN ACT to Provide for the Refunding to Certain Counties in this State of the Funds which Have been or May Hereafter be Paid Into the State Treasury Under the Provisions of Section 1703 of the Revised Codes of North Dakota.

Be it Enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of North Dakota:

§ 1. STATE TREASURER SHALL REFUND IN CERTAIN CASES.] The State Treasurer is hereby empowered and directed to refund not later than July 1, 1897, to the county treasurer of any county all funds which such county has paid into or may hereafter pay into the state treasury under the provisions of section 1703 of the Revised Codes. The State Treasurer shall take a receipt from each county treasurer to whom refunds are made for the amount refunded, and shall notify each county auditor of the amount refunded to his county.

§ 2. DEPOSITED IN GENERAL FUND.] The county treasurer of any county to whom any money is refunded under the provisions of section 1 of this act shall place the same in the general fund of such county, or such other fund as the county commissioners may direct.

§ 3. COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY DESIGNATE DEPOSITORY.] Every county treasurer in any county where any tax levy has been made in accordance with the provisions of section 1703 of the Revised Codes shall hereafter, as fast as the tax is collected, convert the funds into the general fund of such county, or such other fund as the county commissioners may direct, and not pay the same into the state treasury.

§ 4. EMERGENCY.] *Whereas*, The object for which the said tax levy was intended has not been and cannot be accomplished, therefore an emergency exists and this act shall be in force from and after its passage and approval.
