

WHEREAS, The standing appropriation for the state historical society is inadequate to properly pay for the services of a field officer and for a curator of the museum of said society; therefore

Be It Enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of North Dakota:

§ 1. APPROPRIATION.] There is hereby appropriated annually out of any money in the hands of the state treasurer, not otherwise appropriated, for the state historical society of North Dakota, the following sums, viz:

Toward salary of field officer, \$750.

Toward salary of curator of museum, \$500.

§ 2. EMERGENCY.] An emergency exists in this, that the work of the field officer shall begin in March, 1907, therefore this act shall be in force from and after its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 131.

[H. B. No. 309—Miller]

HOSPITALS PROHIBITED.

AN ACT Prohibiting the Establishment of a Hospital for the Treatment of Patients for Pay in Any Residence Block of Any City Without the Consent of the Inhabitants of Such Block.

Be It Enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of North Dakota:

§ 1. PERMISSION TO ESTABLISH REQUIRED.] No hospital for the treatment of disease for pay shall be hereafter established in any residence block of any city in the state of North Dakota without first filing with the city auditor the written consent of the resident freeholders of such block.
