### STATE POULTRY ASSOCIATION.

AN ACT to Provide an Appropriation for the Payment of Premiums and Awards by the North Dakota State Poultry Association, and to Provide for the Establishment of a State Poultry Association.

*Be It Enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of North Dakota:*

§ 1. APPROPRIATION.] There is hereby appropriated out of the funds of the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of three hundred dollars annually, to be expended by the North Dakota poultry association in payment of premiums and special awards in connection with its annual exhibits.

§ 2. ANNUAL EXHIBITION.] For the purpose of promoting, improving and increasing the poultry industry, an annual exhibition shall be held subject to the conditions hereinafter named.

§ 3. CONDITIONS TO BE COMPLIED WITH.] The present North Dakota poultry association, organized under the general laws of this state in relation to corporations, is hereby created as the North Dakota state poultry association; provided, however, that the state shall never become liable for any of the debts or liabilities of said association. The association shall adopt and file with the secretary of state an irrevocable by-law consenting, and providing that its board of directors shall consist of ten persons; that the commissioner of agriculture and labor shall ex-officio, constitute one member of said board of directors.

§ 4. APPOINTMENT AND DUTIES OF EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.] The board of directors of such institution shall appoint an executive committee which shall keep an accurate account of the expenditures of all moneys appropriated to it by the state and all other receipts and expenditures and shall collect all information in their power in relation to the poultry industry in the state, and report the same, together with a statement of their doings, to the governor on or prior to the first day of January each year following the holding of the annual exhibition, and by the governor laid before the legislative assembly. All moneys hereby appropriated shall be paid over to the treasurer of the association on the order of the president, attested by the secretary.
