CHAPTER 327.

PENALTY FOR OBSTRUCTING WATER COURSES.

AN ACT Providing a Penalty for Obstructing Water Courses or Diverting the Water Therefrom, and Providing a Penalty Therefor.

Be It Enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of North Dakota:

§ 1. OBSTRUCTION OF WATER COURSES. PENALTY.] If any person, municipality or corporation, without authority of law, wilfully obstructs any ditch, drain, or water course, or diverts the water therein from its natural or artificial course, such person or corporation shall be liable to the party suffering injury from such obstruction or diversion for the full amount of the injury occasioned thereby, and in addition thereto shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding \$100.00; or in lieu thereof, the offending party, if not a corporation, may be imprisoned in the county jail for a period not exceeding three months.

§ 2. EMERGENCY.] An emergency is hereby declared to exist in this, that no law exists preventing the obstruction of water courses and ditches therefrom. This act shall take effect immediately after its passage and approval.

TRANSFERRING OF WOLF BOUNTY FUNDS.

AN ACT Transferring Funds from the State Wolf Bounty Fund of This State, to the General Fund of the State.

Be It Enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of North Dakota:

§ 1. There is hereby transferred from the state wolf bounty fund of this state, to the general fund of the state, the sum of fifty thousand dollars; provided, that said transfer shall be made by the state auditing board from time to time as a surplus may accumulate in said wolf bounty fund.
