**Item Description**

**Lewis and Clark Bicentennial** - The 2001 Legislative Assembly appropriated \$174,948 from the general fund to the Council on the Arts for Lewis and Clark Bicentennial activities:

**Status/Result**

The agency has allocated \$60,000 of the grants appropriation for grants to communities, limited to no more than \$3,000 per community per fiscal year. Through February 28, 2002, one community grant has been approved for Williston in the amount of \$2,088. The agency anticipates that the remaining amount will be used to provide grants to communities during fiscal years 2002 and 2003.

The agency has allocated the remaining \$106,198 for grants to organizations for various Lewis and Clark related programs and projects. Through February 28, 2002, 11 projects have been approved totaling \$101,138. Nine are scheduled for 2002 and two are scheduled for 2003. Some projects involve multiple sites, activities, and dates.
