House Bill No. 1311 - Department of Public Instruction - House Action

This bill provides a \$119,917 general fund appropriation to the Department of Public Instruction for reimbursing eligible school districts that received reduced amounts of state aid during the second year of the 2003-05 biennium because the district's general fund levy fell below 140 mills as the result of a reorganization or the dissolution of a contiguous district.
