STATE EMPLOYEE SALARY EQUITY FUNDING

2009-11 EXECUTIVE BUDGET RECOMMENDATION

The 2009-11 executive budget recommends funding of \$24,373,396, of which \$13,723,095 is from the general fund, for state agencies to address salary equity issues. Agencies may use the funding to address salary equity issues relating to the competitive employment market, salary issues in targeted occupations, and internal agency and interagency salary equity issues. The \$24,373,396 includes \$1,205,011, of which \$694,483 is from the general fund, for the related salary increase for the second year of the 2009-11 biennium. A summary of the recommended salary equity funding by agency is attached as Appendix A.

2005-07 AND 2007-09 LEGISLATIVE APPROPRIATIONS

The 2005 Legislative Assembly appropriated funding totaling \$1,694,467, of which \$1,666,258 was from the general fund, to the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (\$1,500,000) and

Highway Patrol (\$194,467) for state employee salary equity adjustments for the 2005-07 biennium.

The 2007 Legislative Assembly appropriated funding totaling \$2,703,735, of which \$2,023,989 was from the general fund, to several state agencies for state employee salary equity adjustments for the 2007-09 biennium. The 2007 Legislative Assembly also appropriated \$5 million from the general fund and \$5 million from other funds to the Office of Management and Budget for statewide salary equity adjustments for classified state employees for the 2007-09 biennium. The Office of Management and Budget allocated \$4,998,143 of the \$5 million general fund appropriation and \$3,541,747 of the \$5 million appropriated from other funds to agencies based on classified employees' positions in salary ranges.

A summary by agency of the total funds provided for salary equity adjustments for the 2005-07 and 2007-09 bienniums and the recommended salary equity funding for the 2009-11 biennium is attached as Appendix B.
