¹ This bill provides a \$262,500 special funds appropriation from the student loan trust fund for the purpose of reducing the amount of tuition and other costs payable by or on behalf of eligible students enrolled in the veterinary medical education program at Kansas State University. The Senate also added a section providing that the State Board of Higher Education develop a plan for the continuation of funding for the program to be included in its 2007-09 biennium budget request from a funding source other than the student loan trust fund.
