Senate Bill No. 2267 - Department of Human Services - Senate Action

This bill provides a \$500,000 general fund appropriation to the Department of Human Services for the purpose of matching funds for services and programs for senior citizens under North Dakota Century Code Section 57-15-56. House Bill No. 1012, the Department of Human Services appropriation bill, includes \$1,662,945 from the general fund for the state mill levy match. Senate Bill No. 2267 also includes a section of legislative intent providing that the department encourage providers, to the extent possible, to allocate additional resources to making available more home -delivered meals for the 2005-07 biennium.
