NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES RELATING TO N.D.A.C. CHAPTER 75-03-21 LICENSING OF FAMILY FOSTER HOMES FOR ADULTS

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Department of Human Services will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Admin. Code Chapter 75-03-21, at 3:30 p.m. on Wednesday, September 10, 2008, in Bismarck, N.D. in the AV room – Room 210, located on the second floor of the Judicial Wing of the State Capitol.

The proposed amendments are to clarify and revise rules relating to the Licensing of Family Foster Homes for Adults to reflect changing needs and practice standards. The proposed amendments are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000. No taking of real property is involved in this rulemaking action.

Section 75-03-21-02, Application is amended to add a family evacuation disaster plan to the required information and verifications for an application.

Section 75-03-21-04, Facility is amended to require the bedrooms for all residents to provide privacy for the resident.

Section 75-03-21-09.1, Criminal conviction – Effect on licensure and operation of home is amended to clarify the impact of direct-bearing offenses of those that reside in the home or act as a caregiver in the home, and to clarify that the department will determine if individual is sufficiently rehabilitated.

Section 75-03-21-10, Substitute caregiver and respite care provider qualifications is amended to add language requiring adult family foster care respite providers to repeat a criminal background check if there has been a lapse in their qualified service provider enrollment, and increases the number of days an adult family foster care provider is allowed to leave a substitute caregiver or respite care provider in charge of the home.

Section 75-03-21-13, Termination of care is amended to waive the thirty-day written notice requirement to move a recipient out of an adult foster care home in the event of an emergency and avoid the return of an individual to the Adult Family Foster Care setting when it could be detrimental to the individual, the residents or the provider.
