NOTICE OF INTENT TO
ADOPT ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Department of Labor will hold a public hearing to address proposed new N.D. Admin. Code chapter 46-05-01 at 1:00 p.m. on June 22, 2009, in the Fort Totten Room, Ground Floor of the North Dakota State Capitol, 600 East Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, North Dakota.

The purpose of the proposed rules is to implement provisions of N.D.C.C. § 14-02.5-11. The proposed rules address:

- Housing for persons who are fifty-five years of age or older
- Eighty percent occupancy
- Intent to operate as housing designed for persons who are fifty-five years of age or older
- Verification of Occupancy
- Good faith defense

The proposed rules are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.

The proposed rules may be reviewed at the office of the North Dakota Department of Labor, 600 East Boulevard Avenue, Department 406, Bismarck, North Dakota 58505-0340.
