NOTICE OF INTENT TO  
AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the State Gaming Commission will hold public hearings to address proposed amendments to N.D. Admin. Code article 99-01.3 on the dates listed below. The purpose of the proposed amendments is to address industry issues, improve accountability, clarify the rules, and implement law changes. The proposed amendments address organization licenses and permits, general rules, accounting rules, bingo, raffles, pull tabs and similar games, sports pools, twenty-one, poker, calcuttas, paddlewheels, pull tab and prize board dispensing devices, bingo card dispensing devices, eligible uses, and distributors and manufacturers of gaming equipment. The proposed amendment is not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.
