NOTES

2001-03 Adjusted Appropriations

The amounts shown include adjustments to reflect each agency's share of the \$5 million funding pool appropriated to the Office of Management and Budget for special market equity adjustments for classified employees and to include general fund allocations received by higher education institutions from the equity and special needs funding pool, the board initiatives funding, and the contingency and capital improvement funding appropriated to the University System.

The amounts shown have been adjusted as follows in order to be comparable to the 2003-05 recommended appropriations:

- The legislative appropriation for Homestead Tax Credit is combined with the appropriation for the State Tax Department.
- The legislative appropriation for State Radio Communications is combined with the appropriation for the Office of Management and Budget.

2003-05 Current Budget Status

The budget status amounts do not reflect the impact of House Bill No. 1441 which allows the state to use general fund money to purchase oil put options. The Tax Department has indicated that the fiscal impact is indeterminable.
