

Other Sections in Bill

Transfer to PACE - Section 7 provides for a transfer of \$28 million from the Bank of North Dakota's current earnings and undivided profits to the PACE fund for the 2013-15 biennium.

Transfer to Ag PACE - Section 8 provides for a transfer of \$2 million from the Bank of North Dakota's current earnings and undivided profits to the Ag PACE fund for the 2013-15 biennium.

Transfer to biofuels PACE - Section 9 provides for a transfer of \$2 million from the Bank of North Dakota's current earnings and undivided profits to the biofuels PACE fund for the 2013-15 biennium.

Transfer to beginning farmer revolving loan fund - Section 10 provides for a transfer of \$6 million from the Bank of North Dakota's current earnings and undivided profits to the PACE fund for the 2013-15 biennium.

Emergency measure - Section 16 declares Sections 7 through 10 to be an emergency measure.

PACE - North Dakota Century Code Section 6-09.14-02 - Buydown interest rates on loans for new or expanding businesses

Ag PACE - Section 6-09.13-04 - Buydown interest rates on agriculture-related loans

Beginning farmer revolving loan fund - Section 6-09-15.5 - Direct loans or to buydown interest rates on loans to beginning farmers for the first purchase of farm real estate or chattels

College SAVE - Section 6-09-38 - Higher education savings plan

Significant Audit Findings

There are no significant audit findings for this agency.

Major Related Legislation

House Bill No. 1078 - Increases the amount the Bank of North Dakota may invest in North Dakota alternative and venture capital investments and early-stage capital funds from \$10 million to \$15 million

House Bill No. 1079 - Extends the use of flex PACE to assist with financing of affordable multifamily housing units through June 30, 2015

House Bill No. 1140 - Provides for a Bank of North Dakota loan of \$40 million to the Western Area Water Supply Authority

Senate Bill No. 2096 - Provides a continuing appropriation for funds received by the Bank of North Dakota relating to the federal student loan program.

Senate Bill No. 2132 - Provides for payments from the rebuilders loan program of up to \$30 million to be transferred to replenish the Bank of North Dakota's profits which were deposited in the rebuilders loan program fund. Payments in excess of \$30 million are to be deposited in the general fund.

Senate Bill No. 2187 - Provides for a medical facility infrastructure loan program to be administered by the Bank of North Dakota, provides a continuing appropriation to the Bank for funds in the newly created medical facility infrastructure fund, and provides for a transfer of \$150 million form the strategic investment and improvements fund to the medical facility infrastructure fund.
