Status/Result

The following is a summary of the status of the Legislative Assembly's one-time funding items:

Propylon Core upgrade	Through March 2024, expenditures related to the
	Propylon Core upgrade totaled \$1,647,405, including \$190,257 paid during the 2021-23
	biennium, pursuant to the emergency clause in House Bill No. 1001. Upgrades related to bill drafting are anticipated to be completed by December 2024, with postsession processing, interim committee, and administrative code functionality to be completed throughout 2025.
Audio and video storage	Audio and video storage expenditures totaled \$97,906 and was completed in February 2024.
Computer and tablet replacement	Computers and tablets for the Legislative Assembly were ordered in May 2024 and are estimated to cost \$551,817.
Chamber upgrades	The woodwork in both chambers was refinished at a cost of \$40,000. The carpet in both chambers has been replaced and is estimated to cost \$106,000. The Legislative Procedure and Arrangements Committee will select a chair style in June 2024 and the chairs will be ordered at that time. The total cost of the chairs is anticipated to exceed the \$80,000 budgeted.
2023 special legislative session	Special session expenditures have totaled \$291,531, including salaries and wages of \$137,464 and operating expenses of \$154,067.
