**Item Description**

**One-time funding** - In Senate Bill No. 2001, the Legislative Assembly appropriated \$4,451,000 of one-time funding from the General Fund for legislative chambers and system upgrades.

**January 2026 special legislative session** - Pursuant to Section 7 of Article V of the Constitution of North Dakota, the Governor called a special session of the Legislative Assembly to convene on Wednesday, January 21, 2026, for the purpose of acting on funding related to the federal Rural Health Transformation Program, and for other purposes as determined by the Legislative Assembly.

**Status/Result**

Through March 2026, one-time expenditures totaled \$1,906,883, including \$389,642 related to legislative chamber upgrades and \$1,517,241 related to the Propylon Core upgrade. Chamber lighting upgrades were completed in December 2025. The Propylon Core upgrade is scheduled to be completed before the 2027 legislative session.

The January 2026 special legislative session convened on January 21, 2026, and adjourned sine die on January 23, 2026. The Legislative Assembly approved 1 resolution and 9 of the 11 bills considered. Expenses incurred for the special session totaled \$211,542, including \$145,182 for salaries and wages and \$66,360 for operating expenses.
