Selected Highlights

- Salary increases of up to 3 percent effective July 1, 2025, and 3 percent effective July 1, 2026
- Health insurance increase of \$250 per month (15.2 percent), from \$1,643 to \$1,893, per employee
- Adds \$1 million of ongoing funding from the general fund for student financial assistance grants, to provide a total of \$30.9 million for the needs-based scholarship program
- Adds \$52 million of one-time funding from the strategic investment and improvements fund, including \$50 million for challenge grants, \$1.1 million for the nursing education consortium, and \$900,000 for financial aid software implementation

Deficiency Appropriations

There are no deficiency appropriations for this agency.

Significant Audit Findings

There are no significant audit findings for this agency.

Major Related Legislation

House Bill No. 1098 - North Dakota scholarship - Expands scholarship eligibility for students interested in a teaching career.

House Bill No. 1171 - Law enforcement scholarship - Establishes a scholarship program for law enforcement family members and provides an appropriation of \$5 million to the State Board of Higher Education to administer the program.

House Bill No. 1179 - Faculty accrued leave - Requires institutions under the control of the State Board of Higher Education to provide accrued leave to faculty with 12-month contracts.

House Bill No. 1221 - Workforce education innovation - Appropriates \$24 million to the State Board of Higher Education for workforce education innovation grants.

House Bill No. 1331 - North Dakota State College of Science capital project - Appropriates \$1.75 million from other funds to the North Dakota State College of Science to construct an artificial turf playing surface.

House Bill No. 1404 - North Dakota scholarship - Expands eligibility for the North Dakota scholarship.

Senate Bill No. 2013 - Permanent funds distributions - Provides distributions to University System institutions from permanent funds established for the benefit of the institutions as follows:

Senate Bill No. 2034 - Higher education funding formula - Ensures institutions with increasing enrollment do not receive reduced funding due to reductions in the credit completion factor and increases funding relating to credits completed in wind energy technology and law enforcement programs.

Senate Bill No. 2147 - Student financial aid - Adjusts eligibility for the career builders scholarship and loan repayment programs and appropriates \$12.2 million for supplemental student financial assistance grants.

Senate Bill No. 2170 - Army reserve scholarship - Establishes a scholarship program for reserve members of the United States Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Air Force, Coast Guard, and Space Force.
