

For the 2021-23 biennium, the fund had \$142,352 of revenue, \$74,871 of expenditures, and a fund balance of \$462,857 on June 30, 2023.

Veterans' postwar trust fund - Section 37-14-14 - The purpose of the veterans' postwar trust fund is to be utilized for programs of benefit and service to veterans or their dependents. For the 2021-23 biennium, the fund had \$484,858 of revenue, \$413,862 of expenditures, and a fund balance of \$8,250,083 on June 30, 2023.


