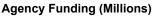

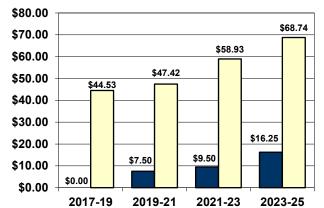
Continuing Appropriations

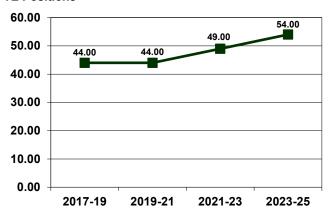
