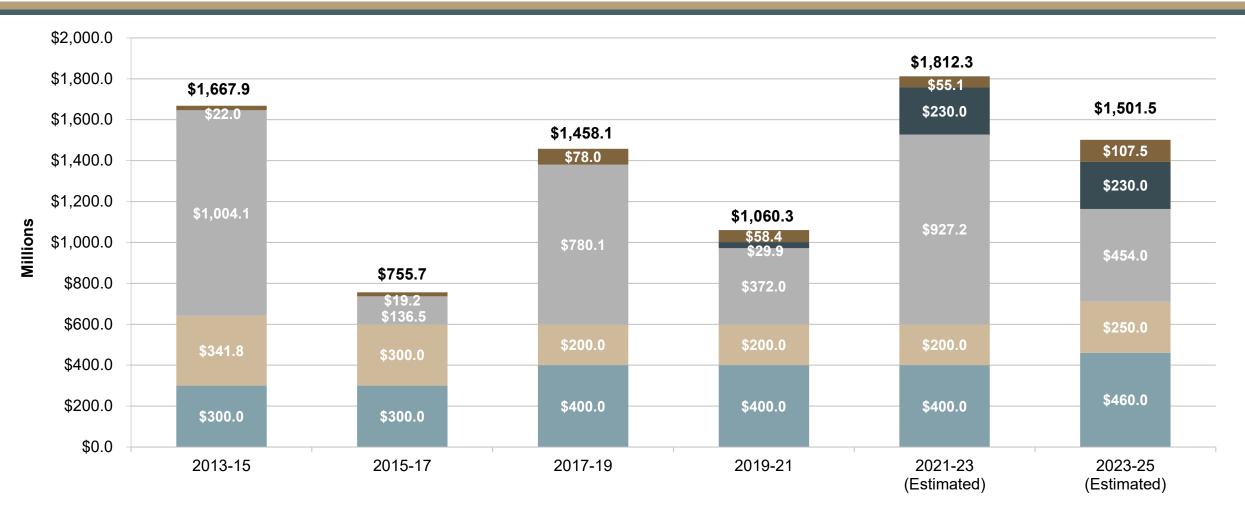
General Fund Revenues - Tax and Fee Revenues



Oil and Gas Tax Revenues - Summary



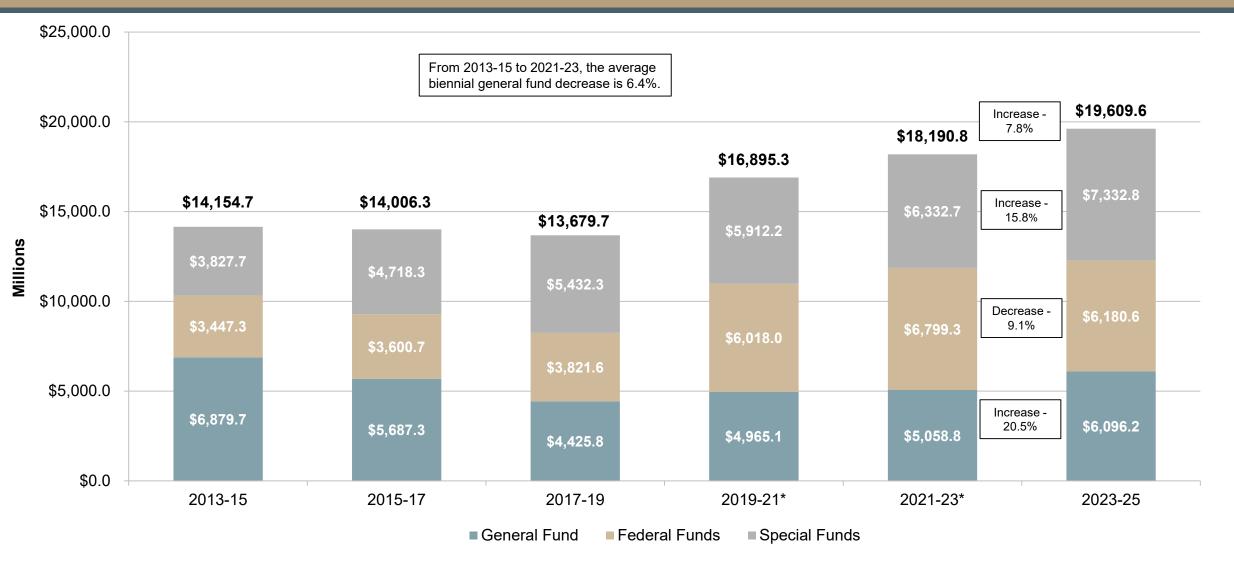
Oil and Gas Tax Revenues - State Share

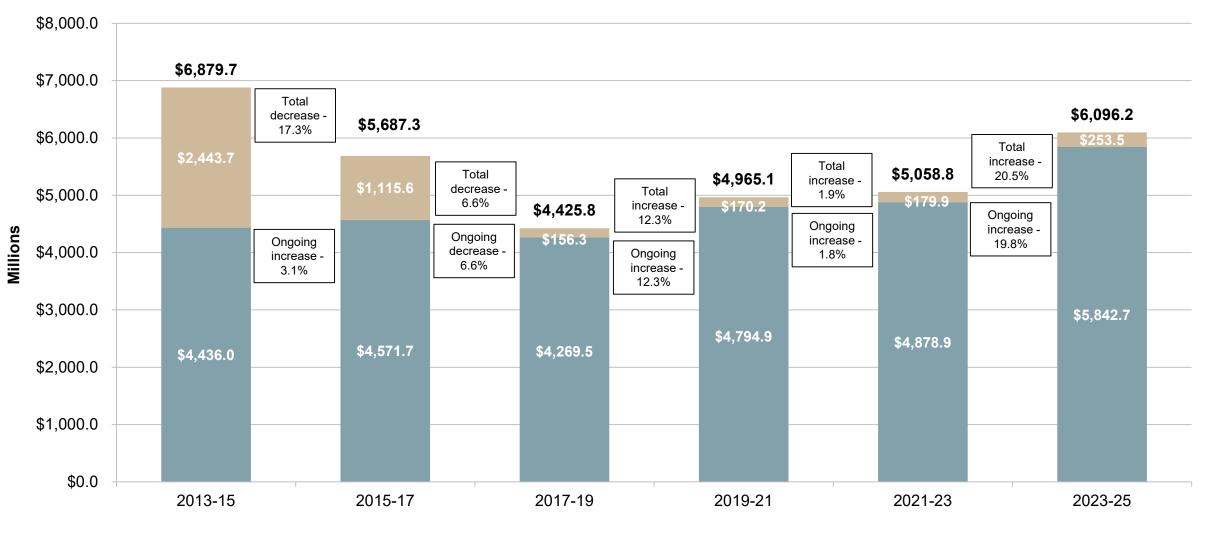

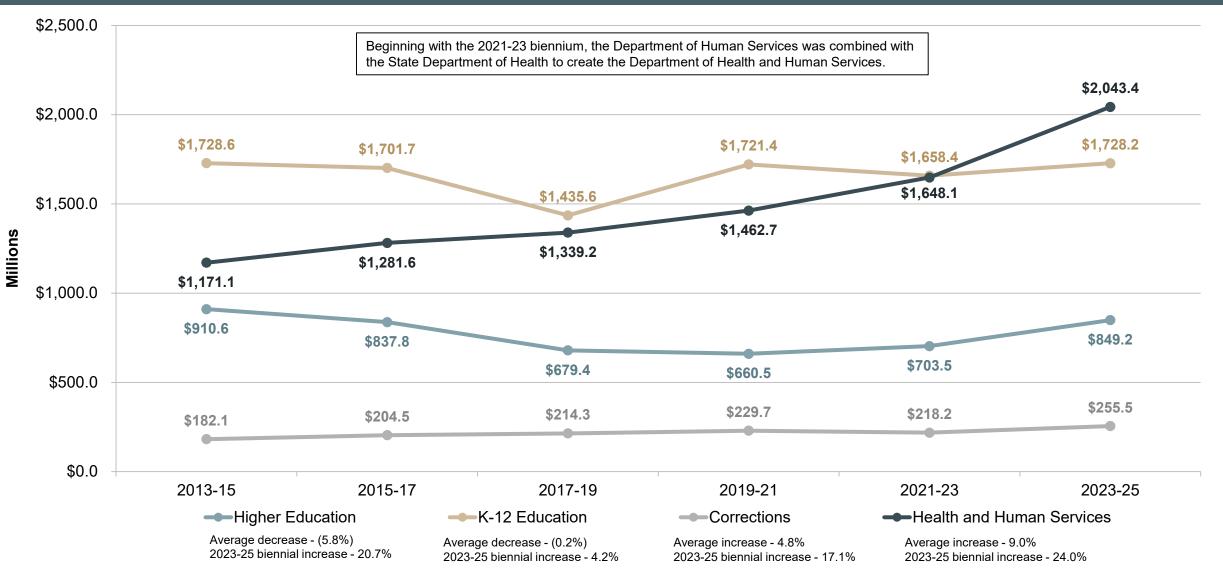

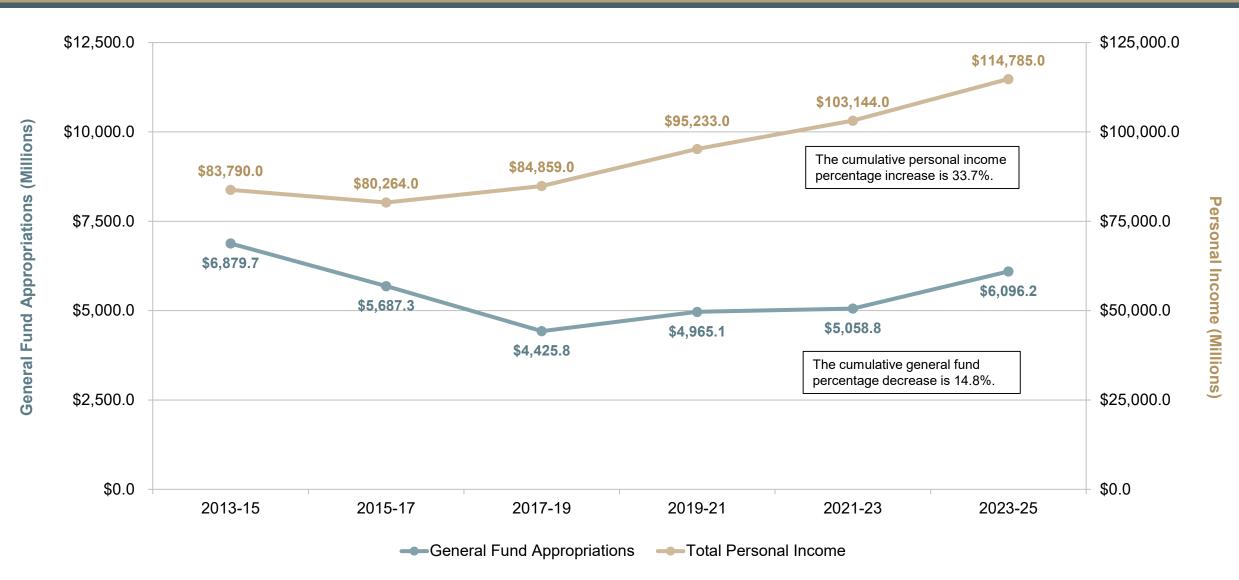

General Fund Appropriations - Major Categories

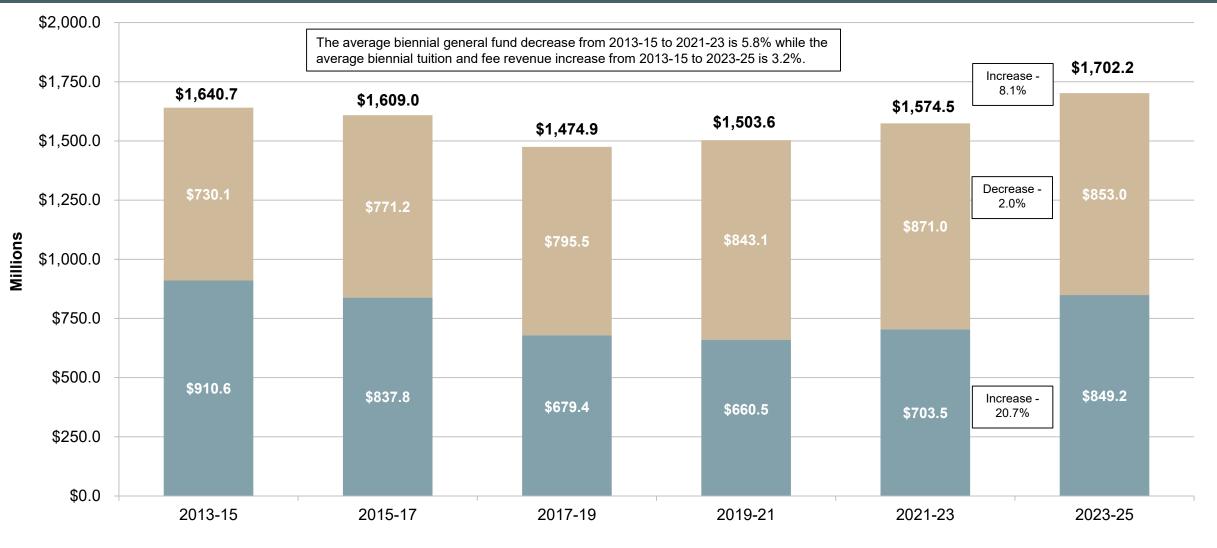


General Fund Appropriations -Comparison to Personal Income



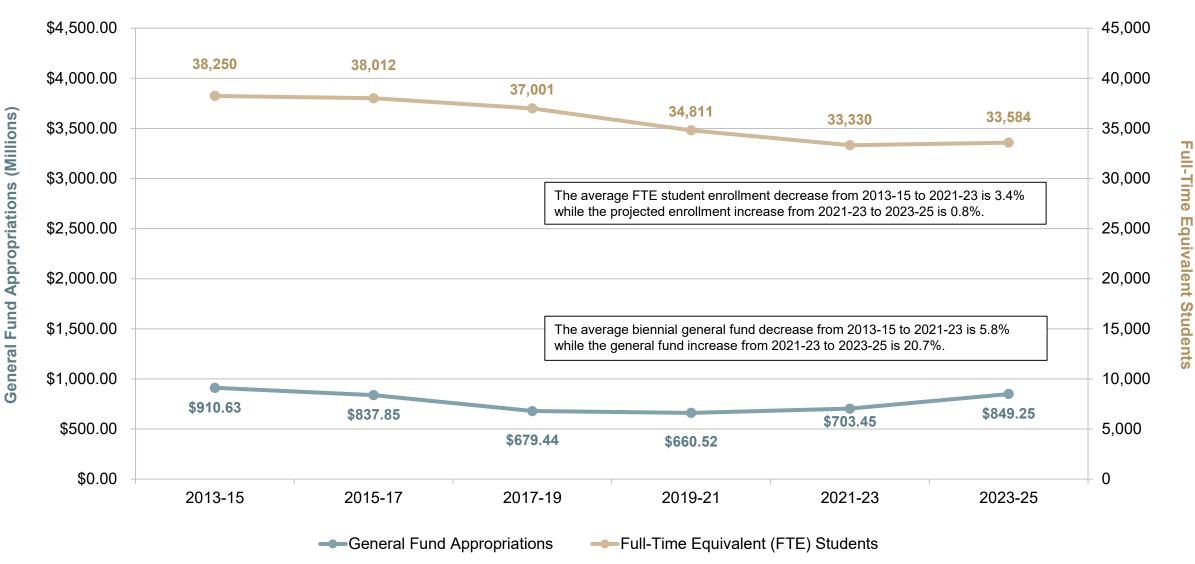

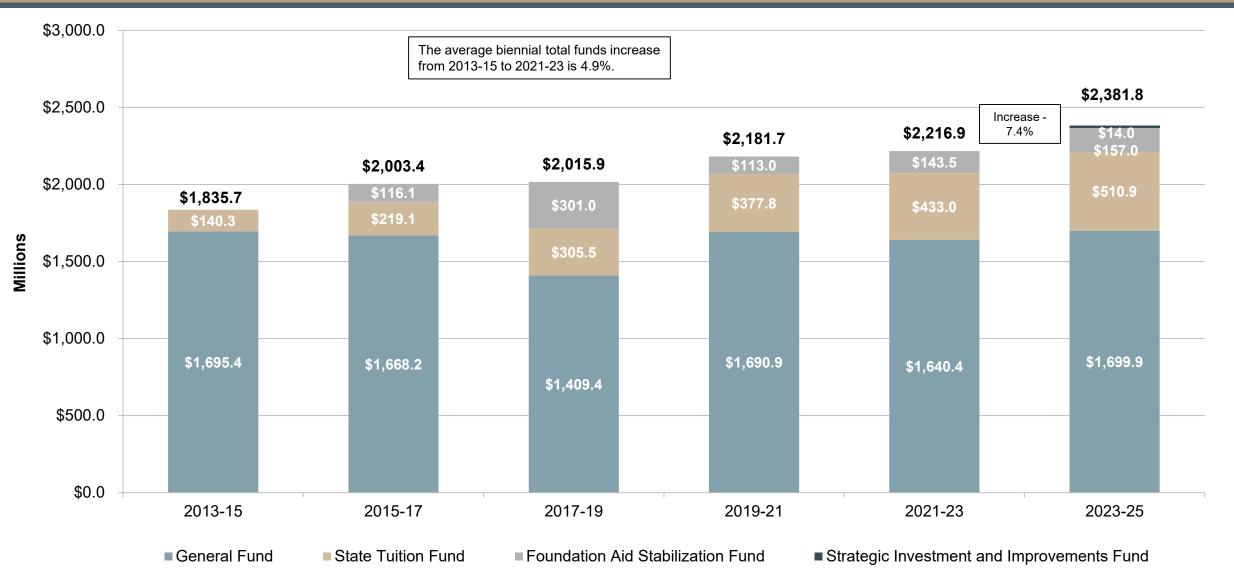

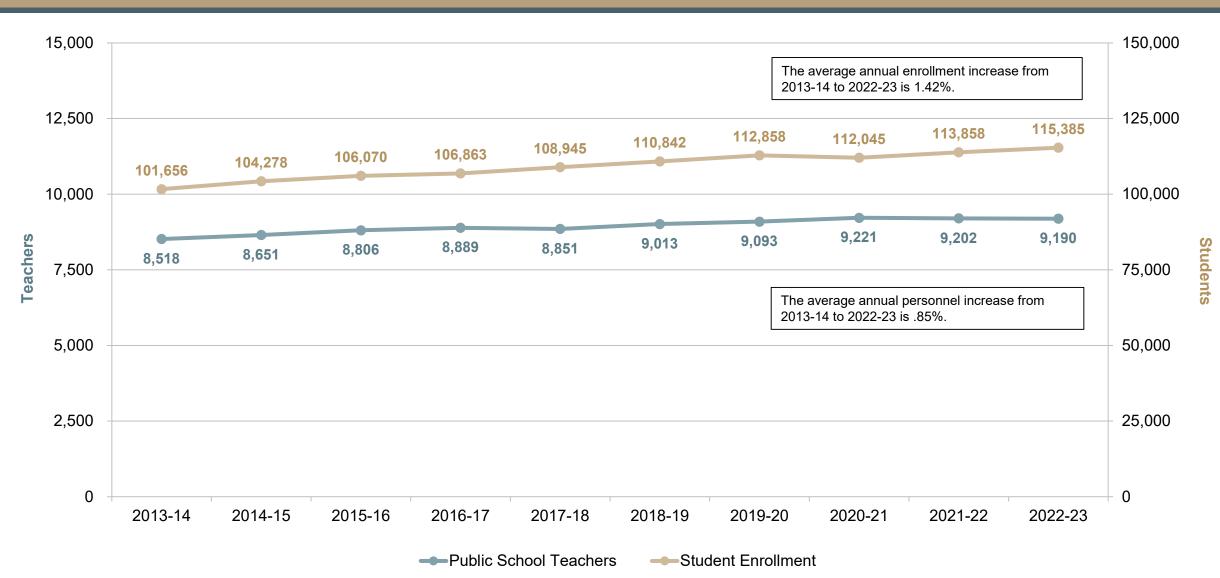
Higher Education - Resident Tuition Rates



Kindergarten Through Grade 12 -State School Aid Funding

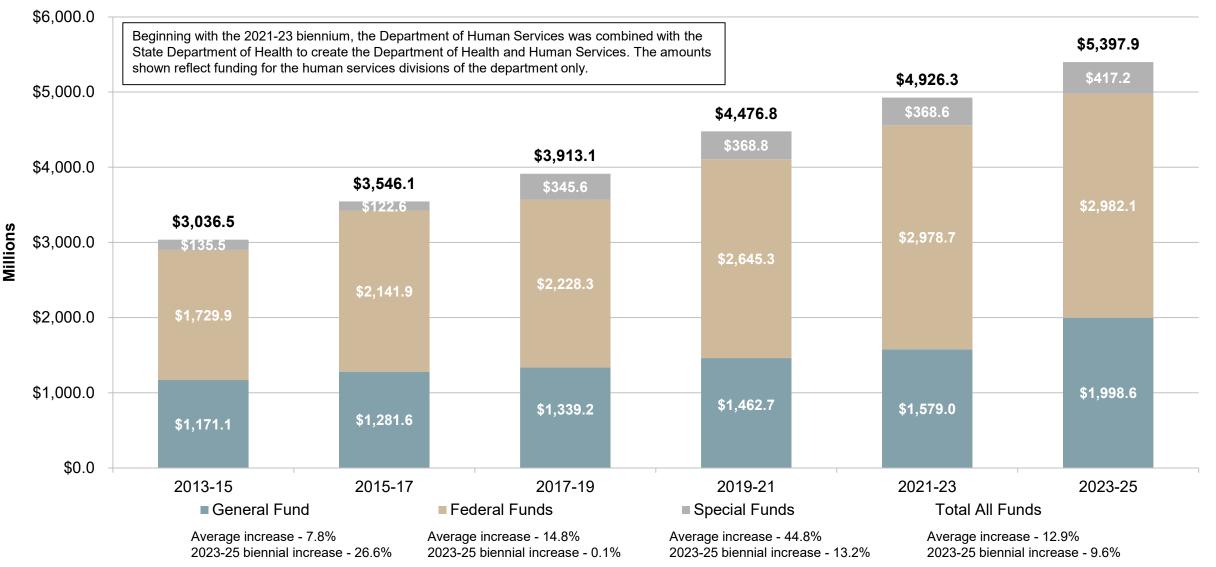

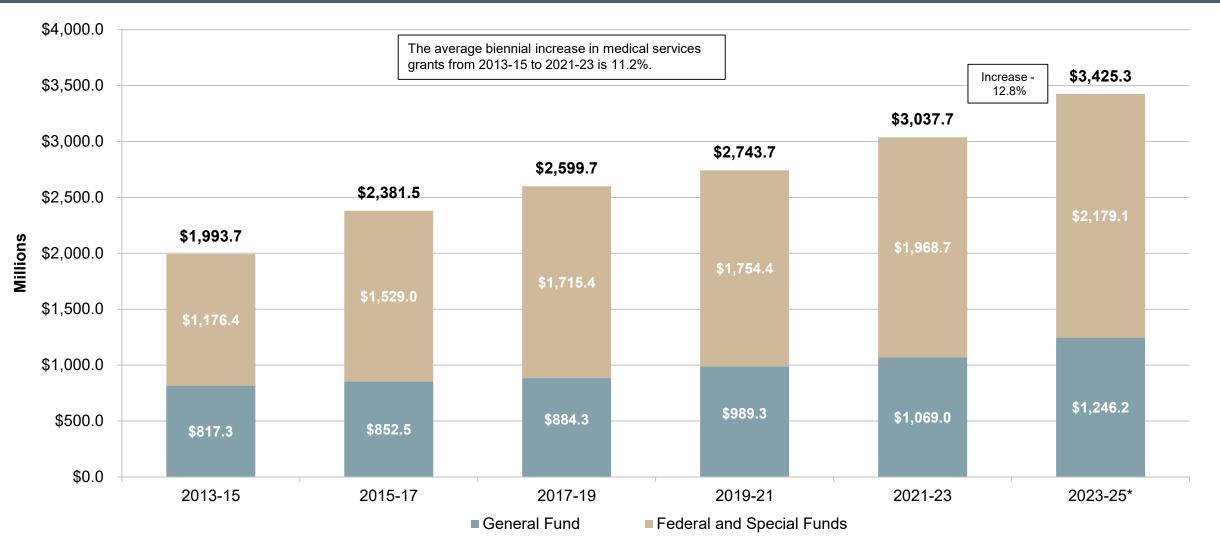

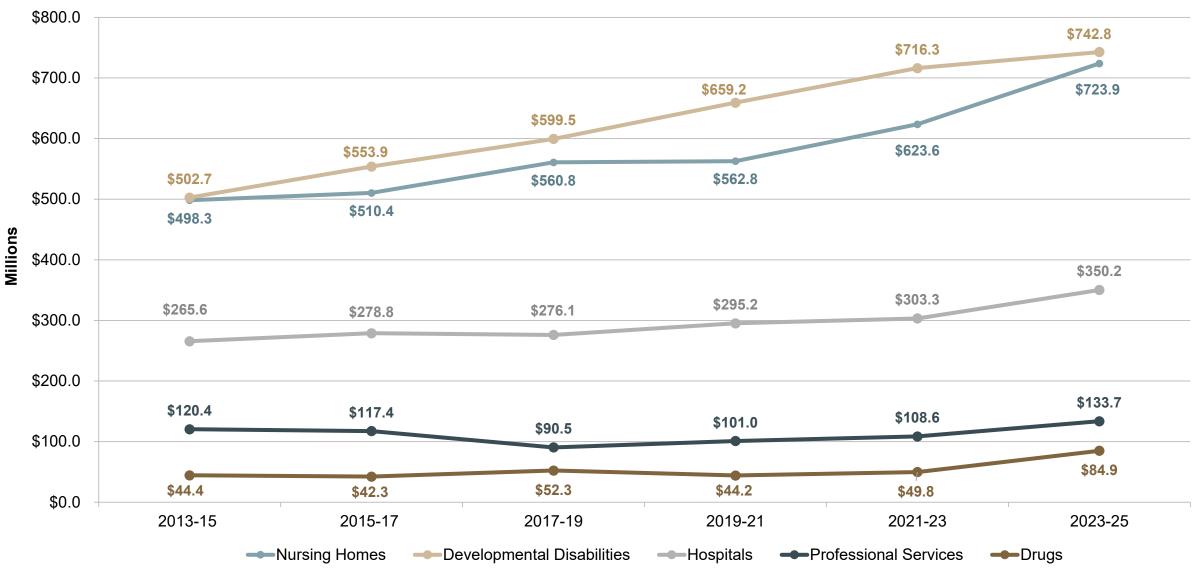


Health and Human Services -Medical Services Grants

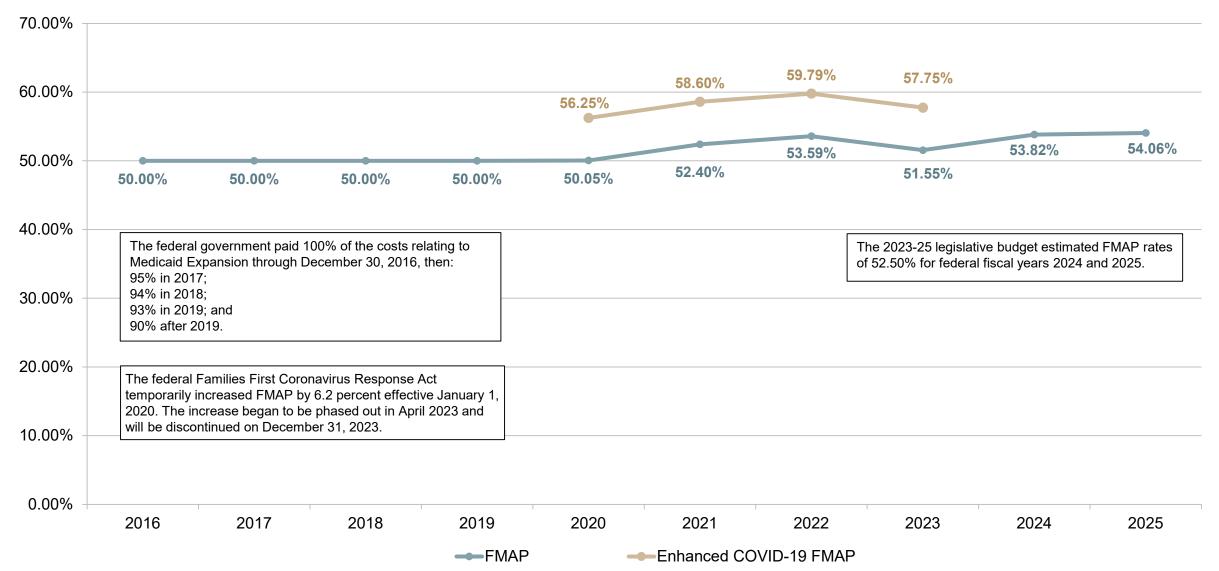
Health and Human Services -Major Medicaid Costs



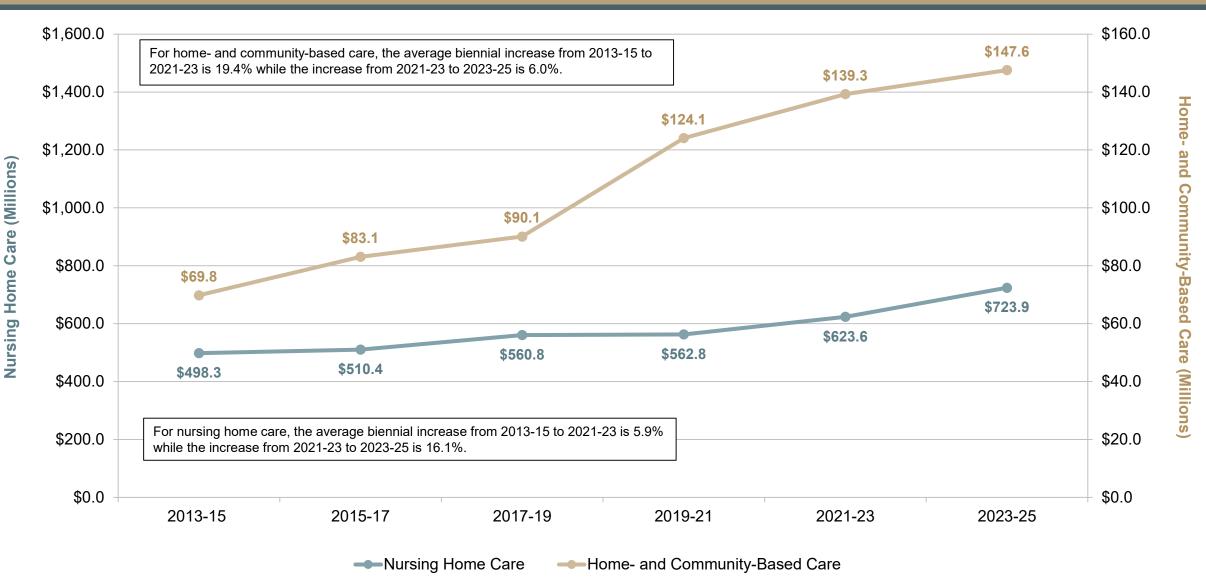

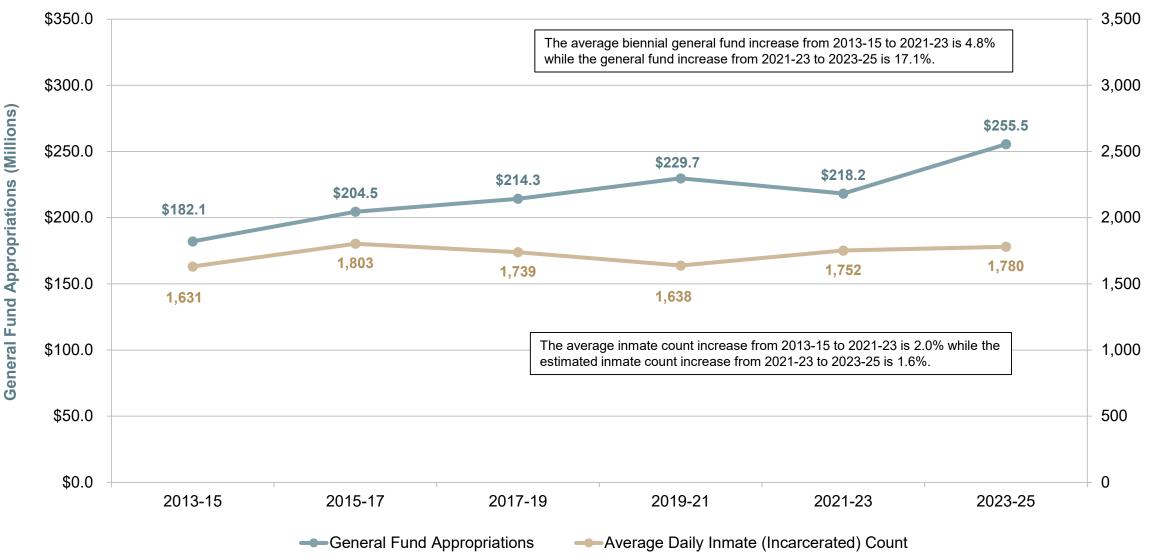
Health and Human Services -Federal Medical Assistance Percentage (FMAP)



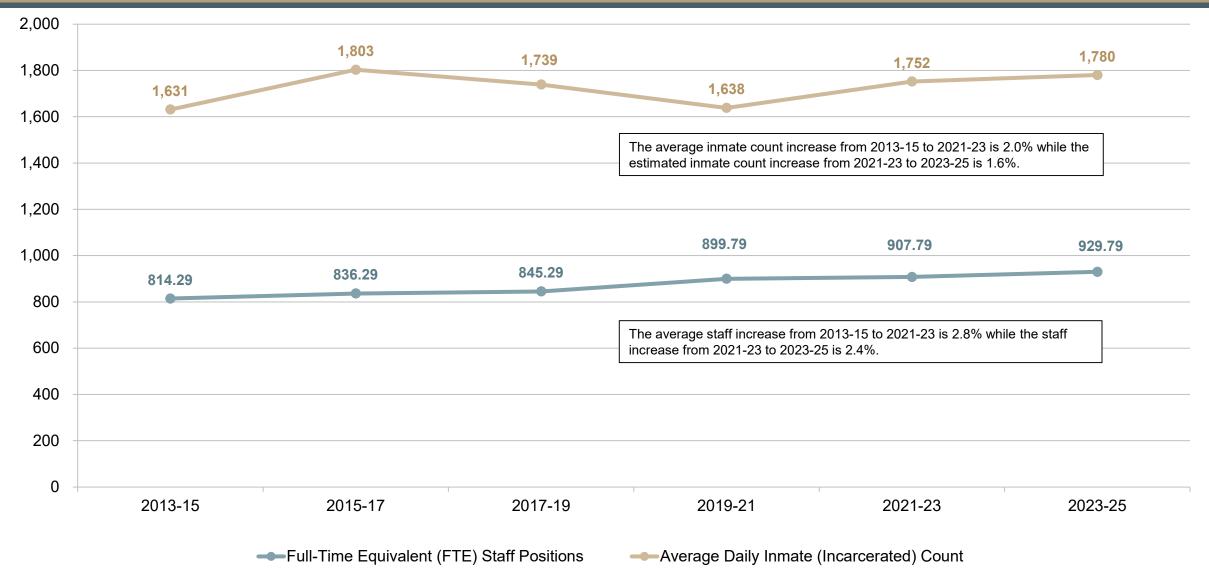
Health and Human Services - Nursing Home and Home- and Community-Based Care



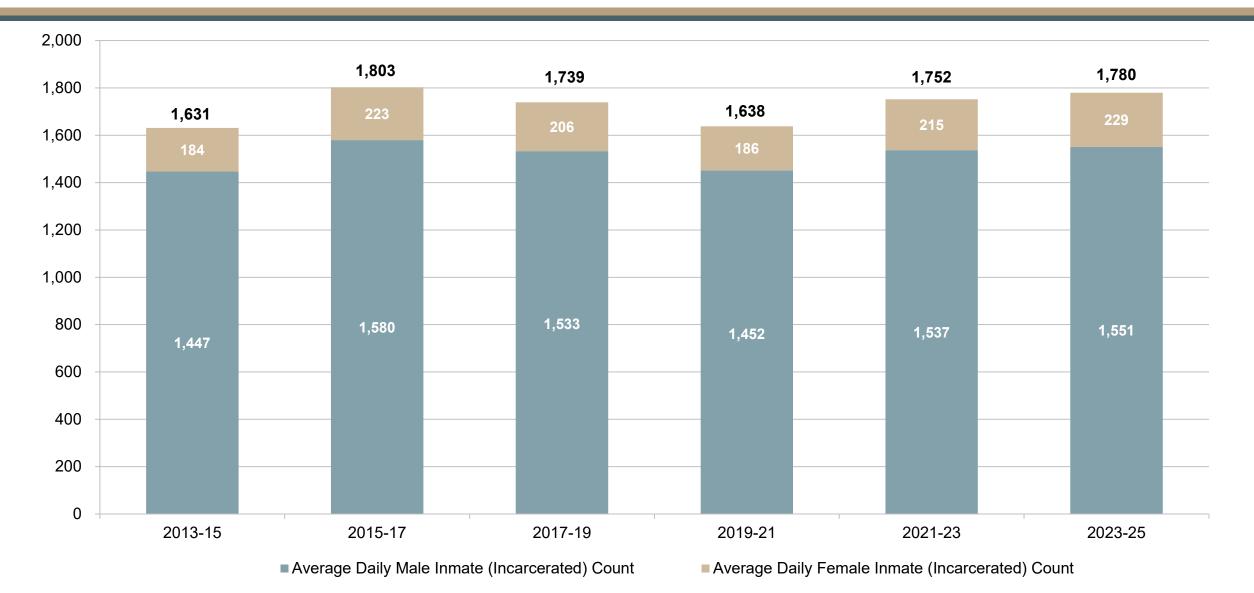
Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation -Appropriations and Inmates



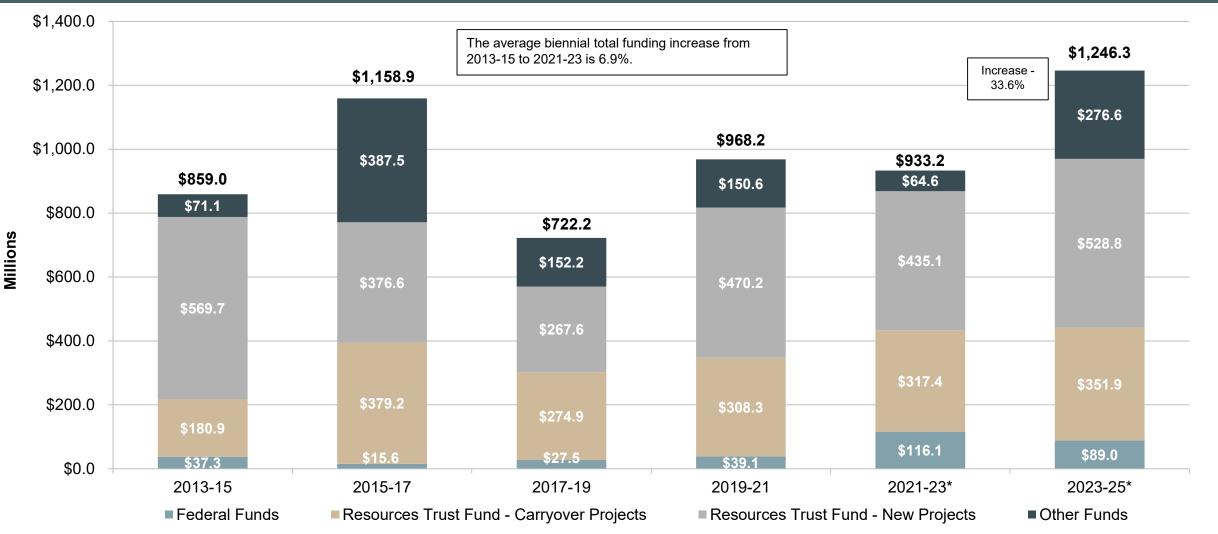
Corrections - Staff and Inmate Counts

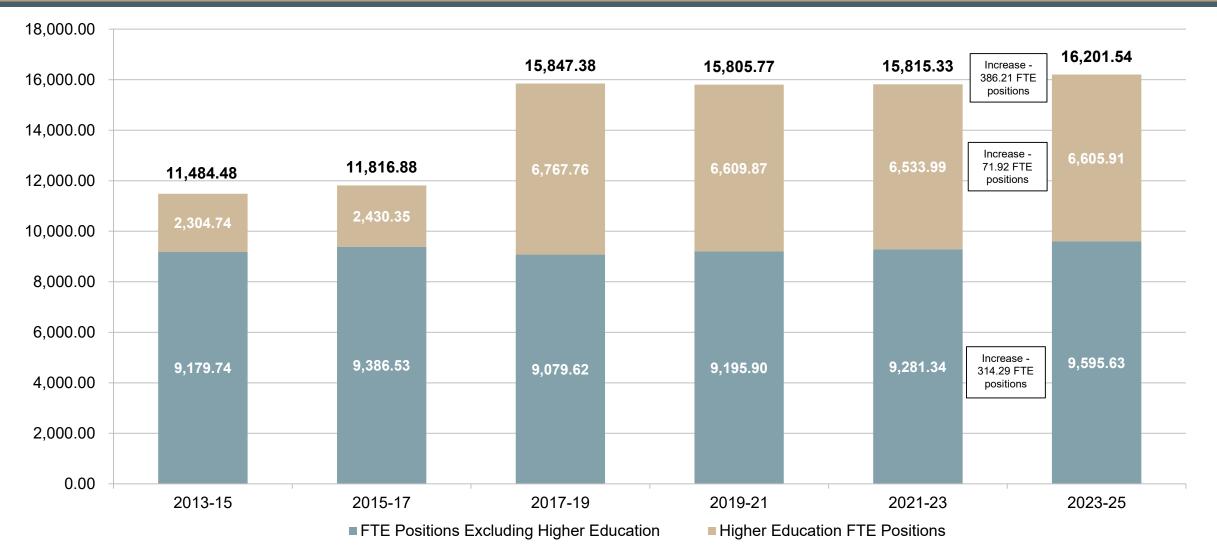

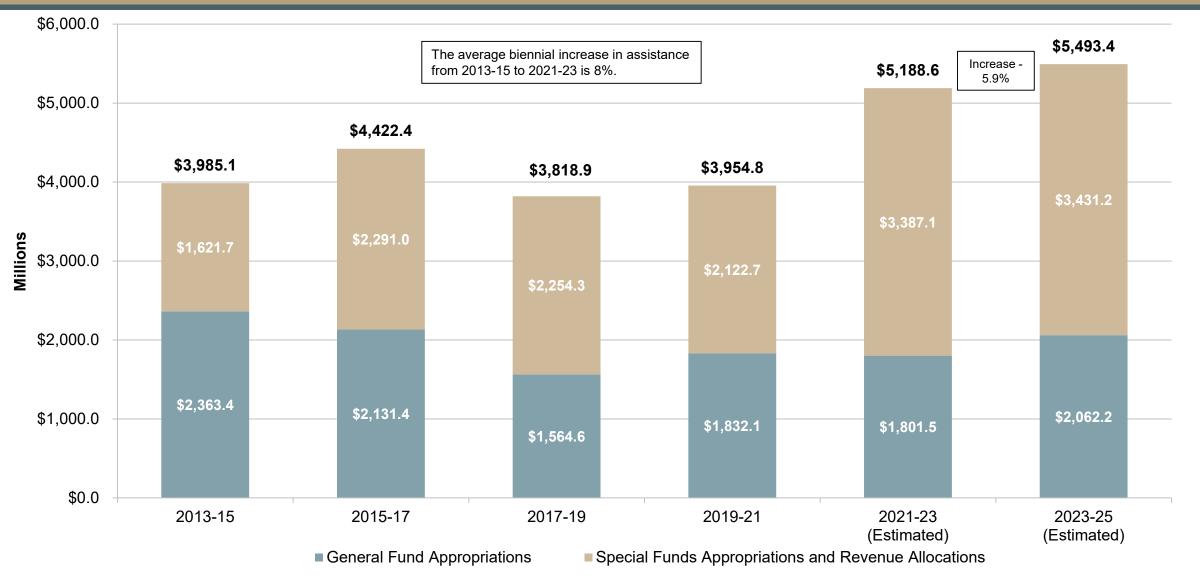

State Employees - Total FTE Positions

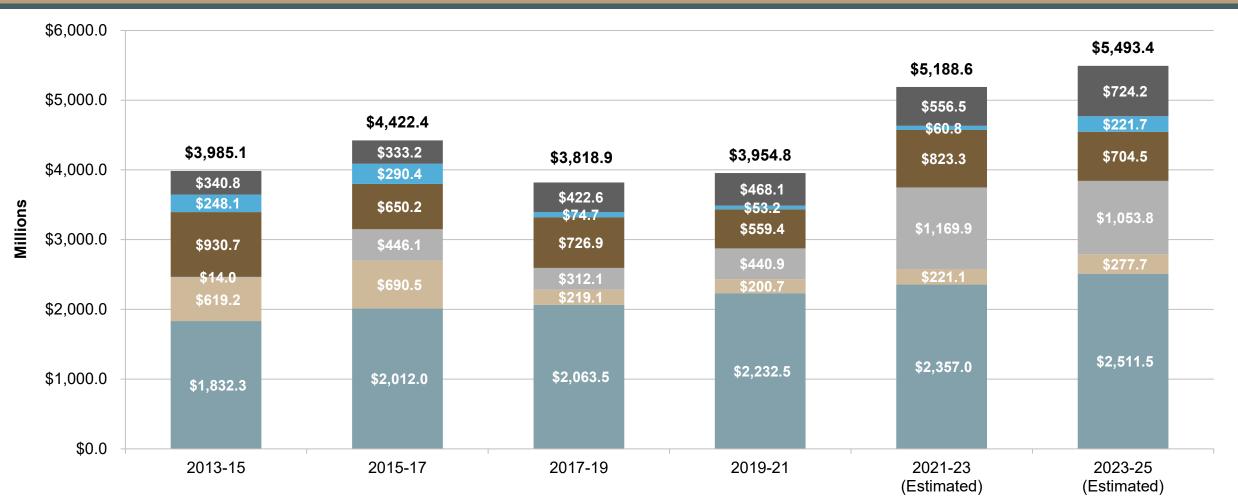
