These include meals for children in poverty, education for students with special needs, and professional development of educators.		
 Provide any other relevant information: We continue to see higher than projected requests for federal grants from the multiple federal programs DPI administers. We believe there are two primary reasons for this. 1. We are capturing more children who qualify for federally paid free and reduced meals. We estimate that we are currently have 95% of those students who are eligible for these programs participating. 2. With the completion of the COVID-19 funding, school districts are now using other federal funding that they were banking the last couple of years for qualifying expenses.
