HB 1316

Your House Transportation Committee recommends a do pass with 11-1 vote.

This bill gives the authorities the ability to revoke a work permit or temporary driver's license after three moving violations.

Revocation under this subsection may only last for a period of 30 days.

An individual who has a temporary restricted driver's license and commits a moving traffic violation is subject to the fee specified for the violation plus an additional fee of \$50.
