- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 39-05 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to a request for a certificate of title for a motor vehicle.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 39-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
 - Request for certificate of title Nonlegal owner.
- 1. If a motor vehicle, which has been issued a certificate of title, has not been registered
 under chapter 39-04 for more than tentwenty-five years, and an individual, who is not
 the legal owner, requests a certificate of title, the individual requesting the certificate of title shall:
 - Send a certified letter to the last-known address at which the motor vehicle was registered.
 - b. Advertise for fourteen daystwice over a thirty-day period a notice of the vehicle title request in a newspaper of general circulation in the county in which the vehicle was last registered.
 - 2. If the individual requesting the certificate of title does not receive a response within fourteenthirty days and provides the department with satisfactory proof of compliance with this section, the department shall issue a certificate of title to the individual under section 39-05-09.
