- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 54-06-14.7 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to shared leave for state employees.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 54-06-14.7 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 54-06-14.7. State leave sharing program Rulemaking. (Retroactive application -

See note)

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- 1. The human resource management services division of the office of management and budget shall establish a state leave sharing program for permanent employees of the state. The program must provide for a mechanism for state employees to donate accrued annual and sick leave to an employee who does not have available leave who is pregnant-or-suffering from a severe, extreme, or life-threatening condition, or who is caring for an immediate relative or household member who is suffering from a severe, extreme, or life-threatening condition.
- 2. A temporary employee or contracted employee with a limited-term appointment is not eligible to participate in the leave sharing program. An employee may not use more than four months donated leave in any twelve-month period and an employee may not retain leave beyond the occurrence necessitating the leave.

For the record, I am Representative Emily O'Brien; I represent District 42 in Grand Forks.

Before you is House Bill 1599, this is a very simple clean-up bill. The initial intention was to allow for pregnancy to be included - but later determined that we are not able to single out one condition.

Page 1, Line 12 - we will need to now remove the addition of "pregnant or" - this should be struck through "pregnant or"

Page 1, Lines 21 - 22 - this is a duplication from line 12. This allows the physician to officially verify the condition - where there is an individual at risk.

If there are technical questions, I would defer those to our Chief Human Resource Office, Mrs. Molly Herrington, from the Office of Management and Budget.
