Good morning, Chairman Warrey and members of the Industry, Business and Labor Committee. My name is Janelle Middlestead, Producer Licensing Director. I stand before you today on behalf of Commissioner Godfread in support of Senate Bill 2092, which is an agency bill addressing licensure date corrections for life settlement producers. SB 2092 is an example of the department streamlining our processes and procedures to make it easier for producers to understand their renewal requirements and updating the year for renewal.

Life settlement producers provide services to the consumer to help them make the best purchase decision when selling their policies to third parties for cash. The producers represent the consumer and assist them with the application process, policy maintenance and acts as an advocate during claims with the life insurance company.

The bill provides updated renewal dates for life settlement producers who are obtaining their license. Updating the dates for this licensing class allows producers to determine when license renewal and payment are due.

Thank you, Chairman Warrey and members of the Industry, Business and Labor Committee. I respectfully request a “do pass” recommendation from the committee and am happy to answer any questions that you may have.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsections 7 and 8 of section 26.1-33.4-02 of the North
6 Dakota Century Code are amended and reenacted as follows:

- 7 7. Licenses may be renewed annually on or before April thirtieth upon payment of the
8 periodic renewal fee. As specified in subsection 2, the renewal fee for a provider may
9 not exceed a reasonable fee. Failure to pay the fee within the terms prescribed results
10 in the automatic revocation of the license requiring periodic renewal. A license issued
11 after January first is not required to renew until April thirtieth of the following calendar
12 year. ~~A license issued between May 1, 20232024, and July 31, 20232024, is not~~
13 ~~required to be renewed until April 30, 20252026.~~
- 14 8. The term of provider license must be equal to that of a domestic stock life insurance
15 company and the term of a broker license must be equal to that of an insurance
16 producer license. Licenses requiring periodic renewal may be renewed on or before
17 April thirtieth upon payment of the periodic renewal fee as specified in subsection 2.
18 Failure to pay the fees before the expiration of the renewal date results in expiration of
19 the license. A license issued after January first is not required to be renewed until April

- 1 | thirtieth of the following calendar year. ~~A license issued between May 1, 2023~~2024,
- 2 | ~~and July 31, 2023~~2024, is not required to be renewed until April 30, 20252026.
