Subsection 1 of section 15-39.1-05.1 of the North Dakota 5 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 6 The authority to set policy for the fund rests in a board of trustees composed as 7 follows: 8 The governor shall appoint, from a list of three nominees submitted to the 9 governor by North Dakota united, two board members who are actively employed 10 as elementary or secondary teachers in full-time positions not classified as 11 school administrators. A board member appointed under this subdivision who 12 terminates employment may not continue to serve as a member of the board. 13 The governor shall appoint, from a list of three nominees submitted to the b. 14 governor by the North Dakota council of educational leaders, one board member 15 who is actively employed as a full-time school administrator. A board member 16 appointed under this subdivision who terminates employment may not continue 17 to serve as a member of the board. 18
 - The governor shall appoint, from a list of three nominees submitted to the governor by the North Dakota retired teachers association, two board members who are the retired members of the fund.
