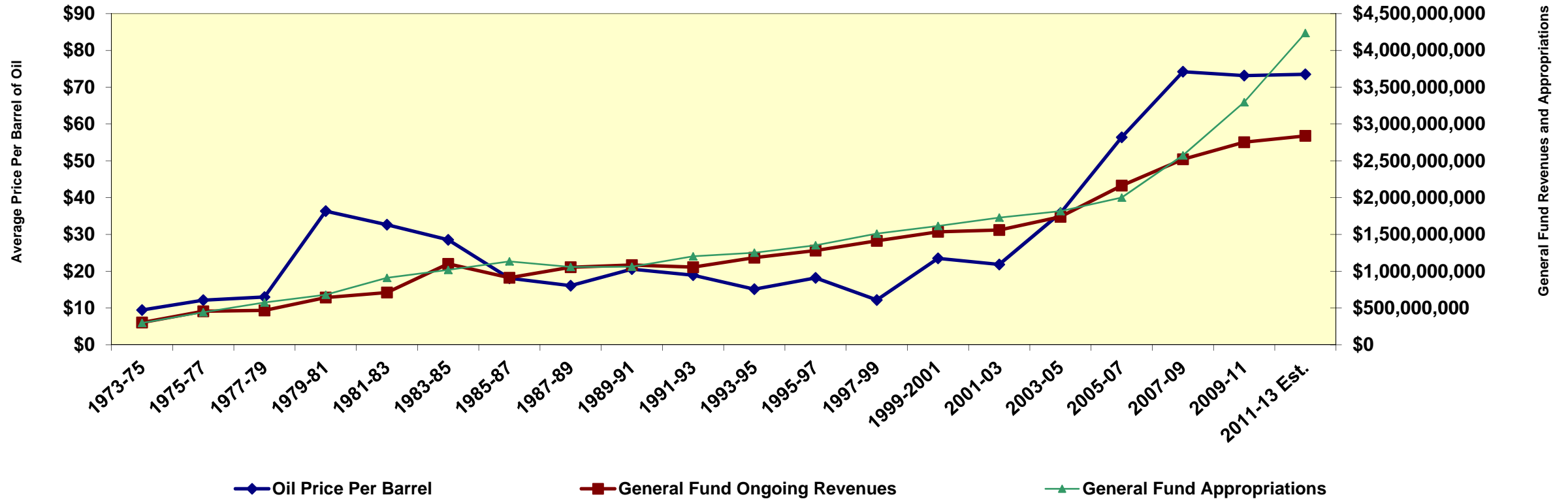

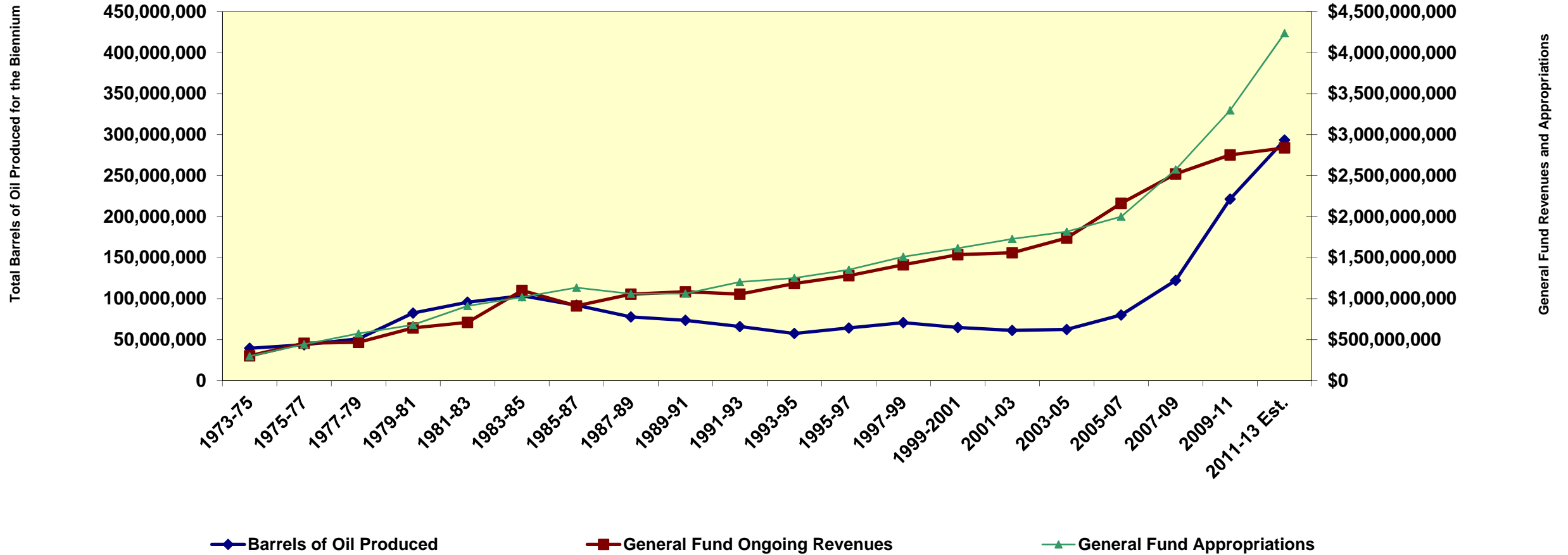

Comparison of Prices Per Barrel of Oil in North Dakota and General Fund Ongoing Revenues and Appropriations



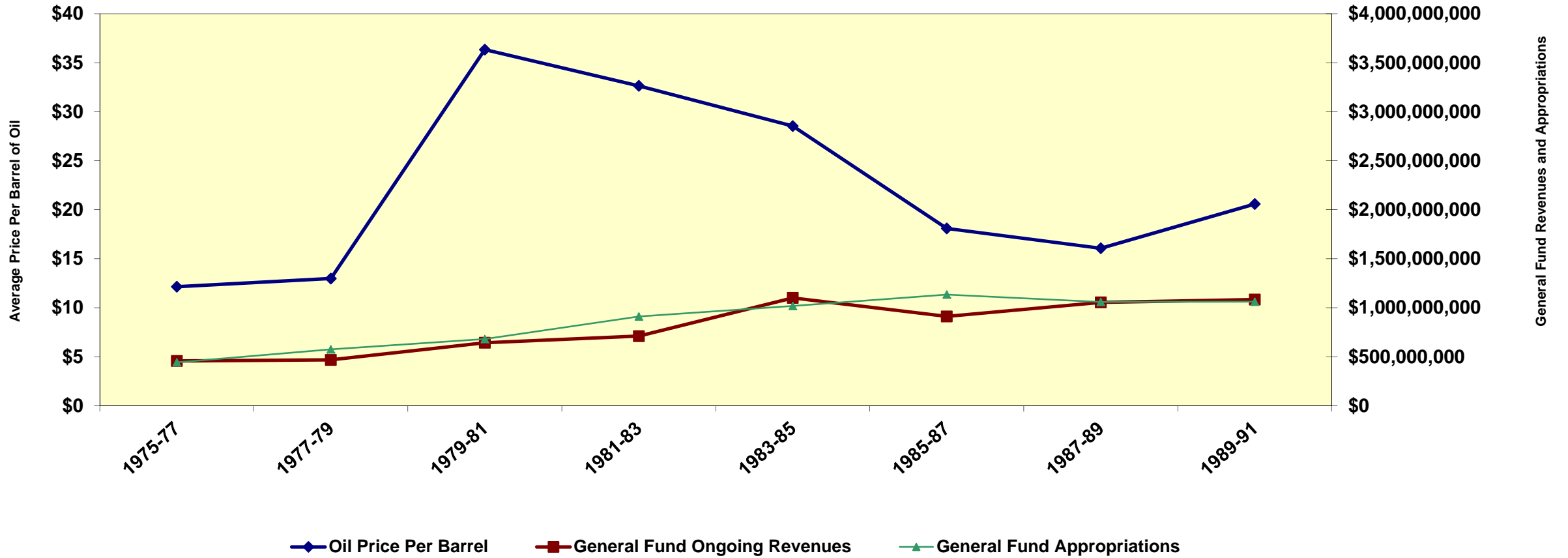

Comparison of North Dakota Oil Production and General Fund Ongoing Revenues and Appropriations

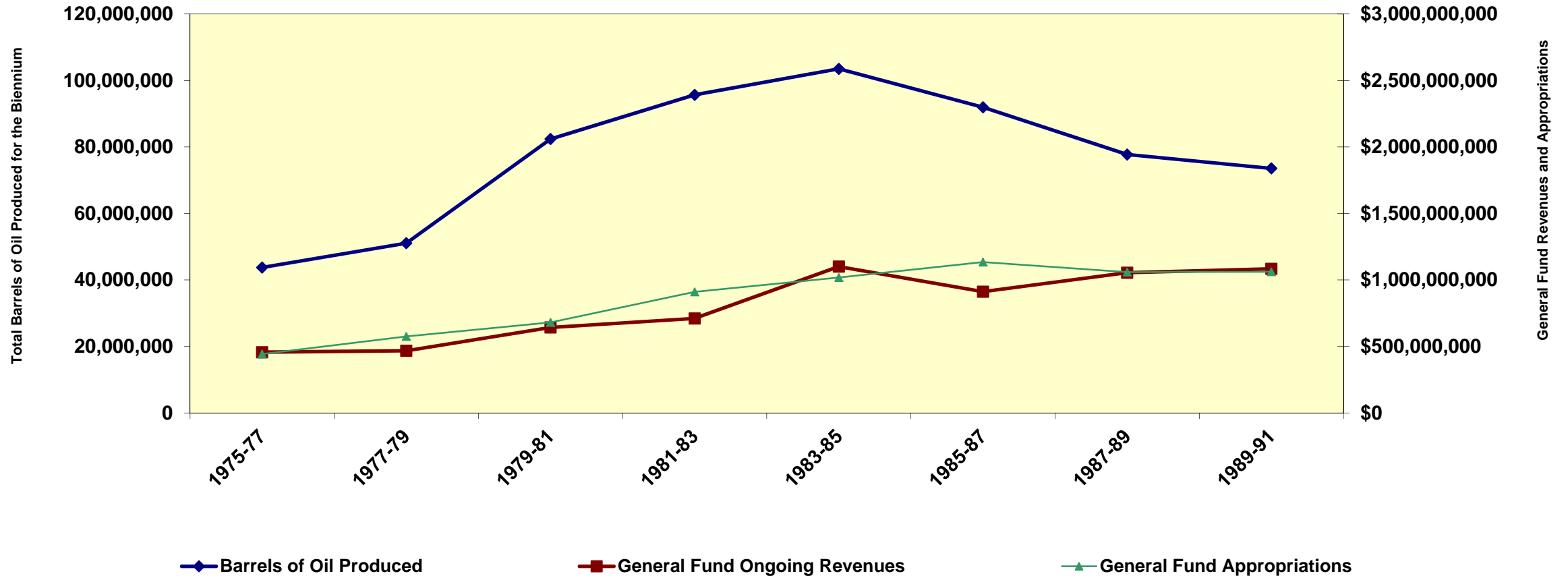

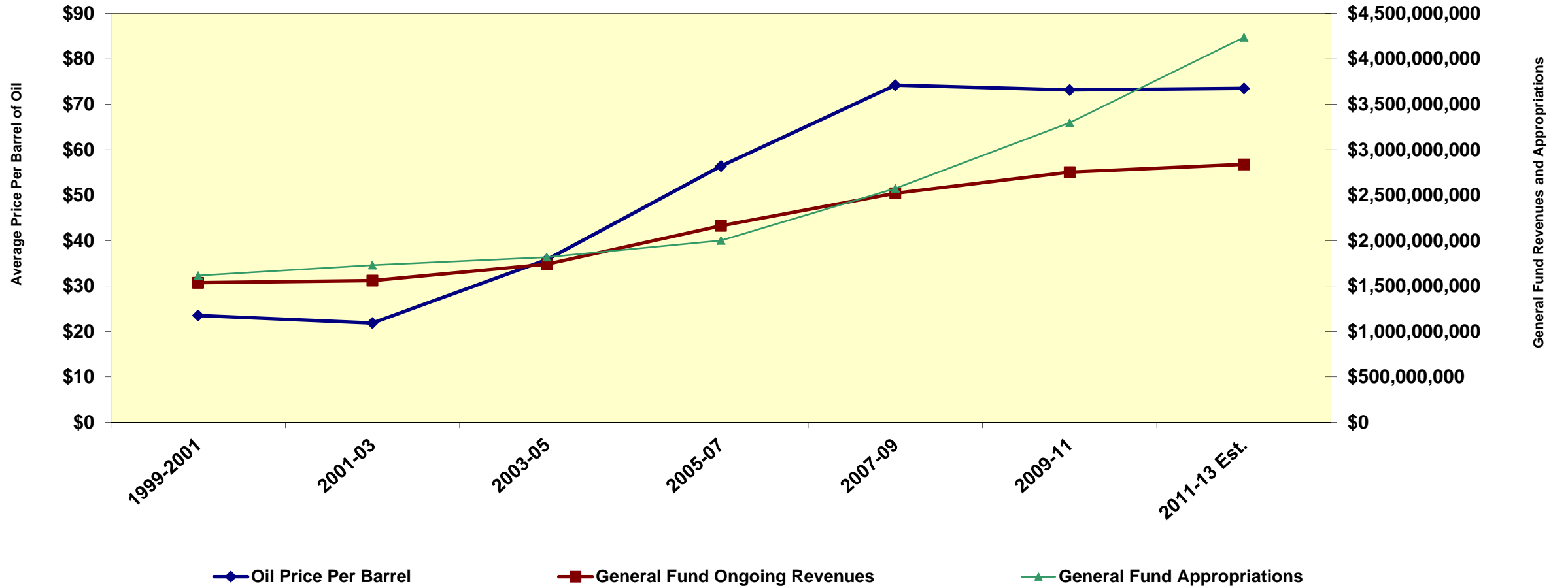
Comparison of Prices Per Barrel of Oil in North Dakota and General Fund Ongoing Revenues and Appropriations From 1975 Through 1991



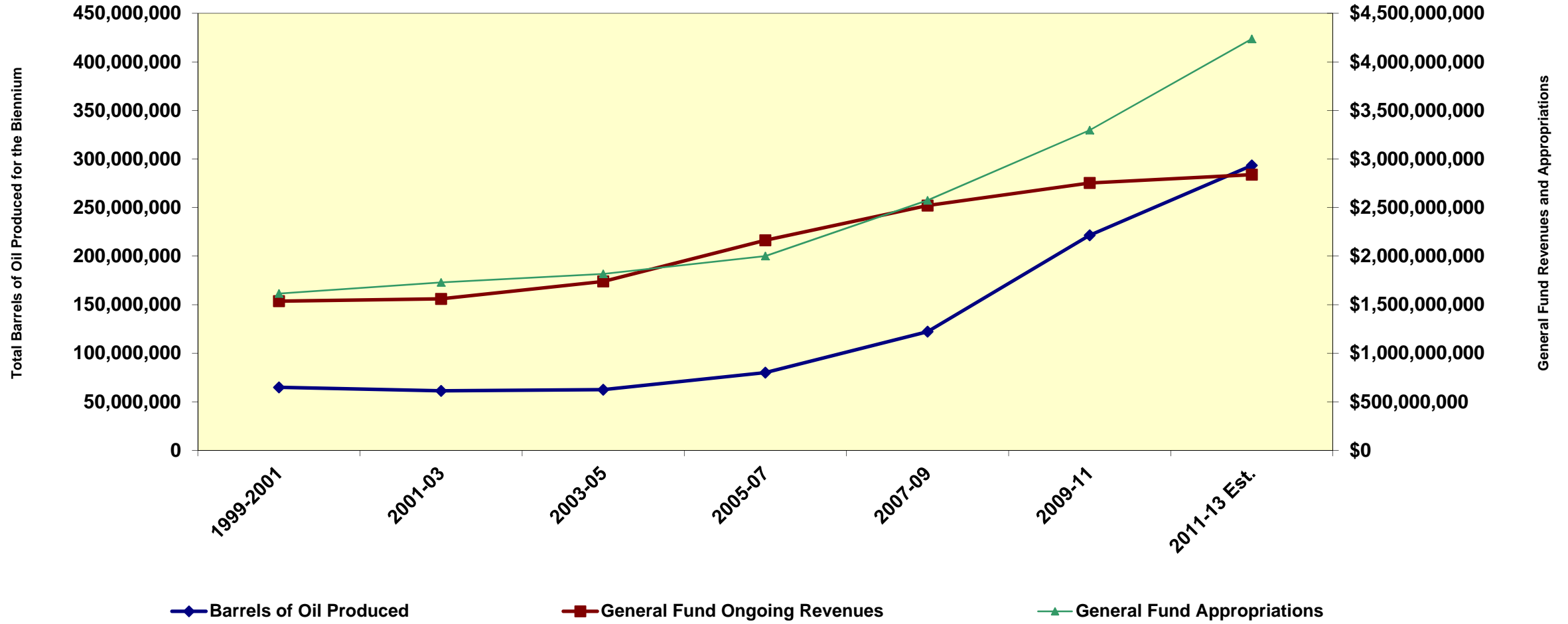
Comparison of North Dakota Oil Production and General Fund Ongoing Revenues and Appropriations From 1975 Through 1991



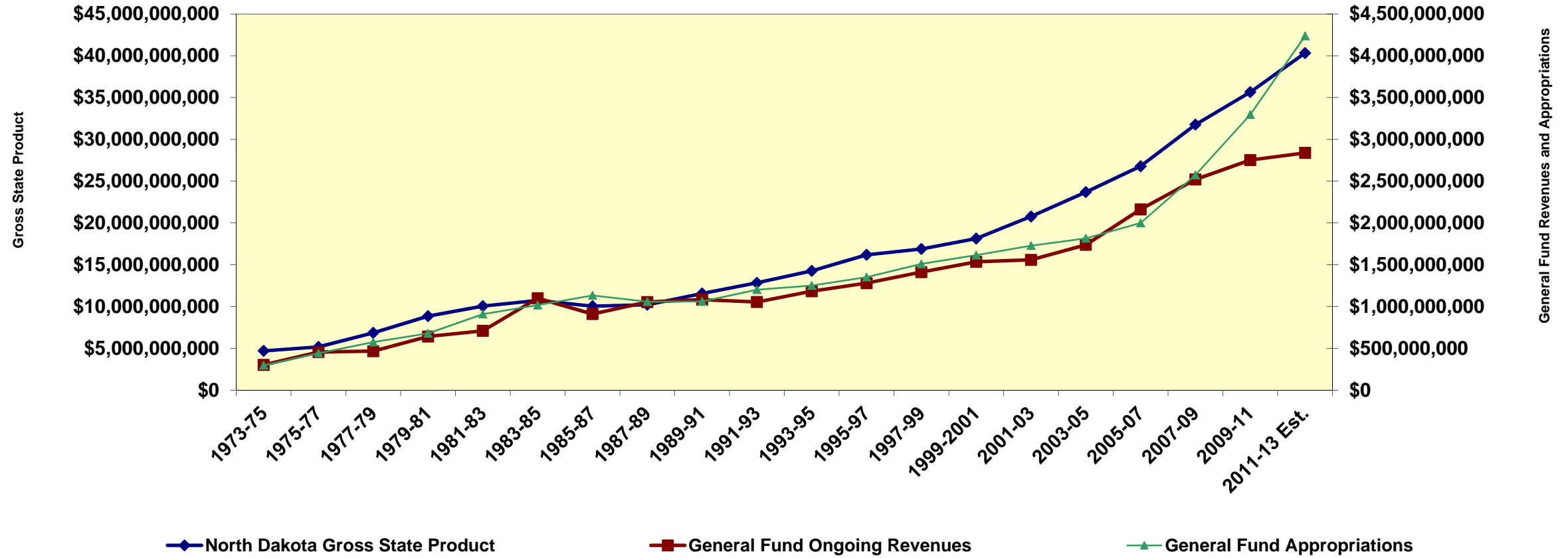
Comparison of Prices Per Barrel of Oil in North Dakota and General Fund Ongoing Revenues and Appropriations From 1999 to Present



Comparison of North Dakota Oil Production and General Fund Ongoing Revenues and Appropriations From 1999 to Present

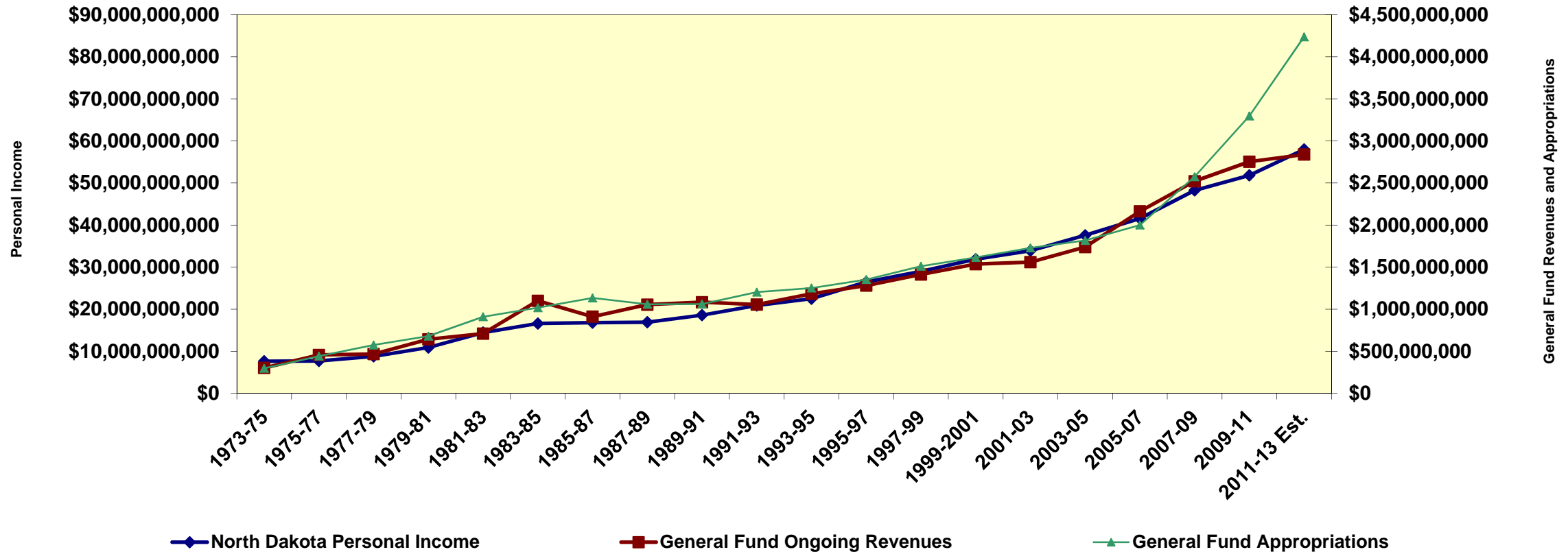


Comparison of North Dakota's Gross State Product and General Fund Ongoing Revenues and Appropriations



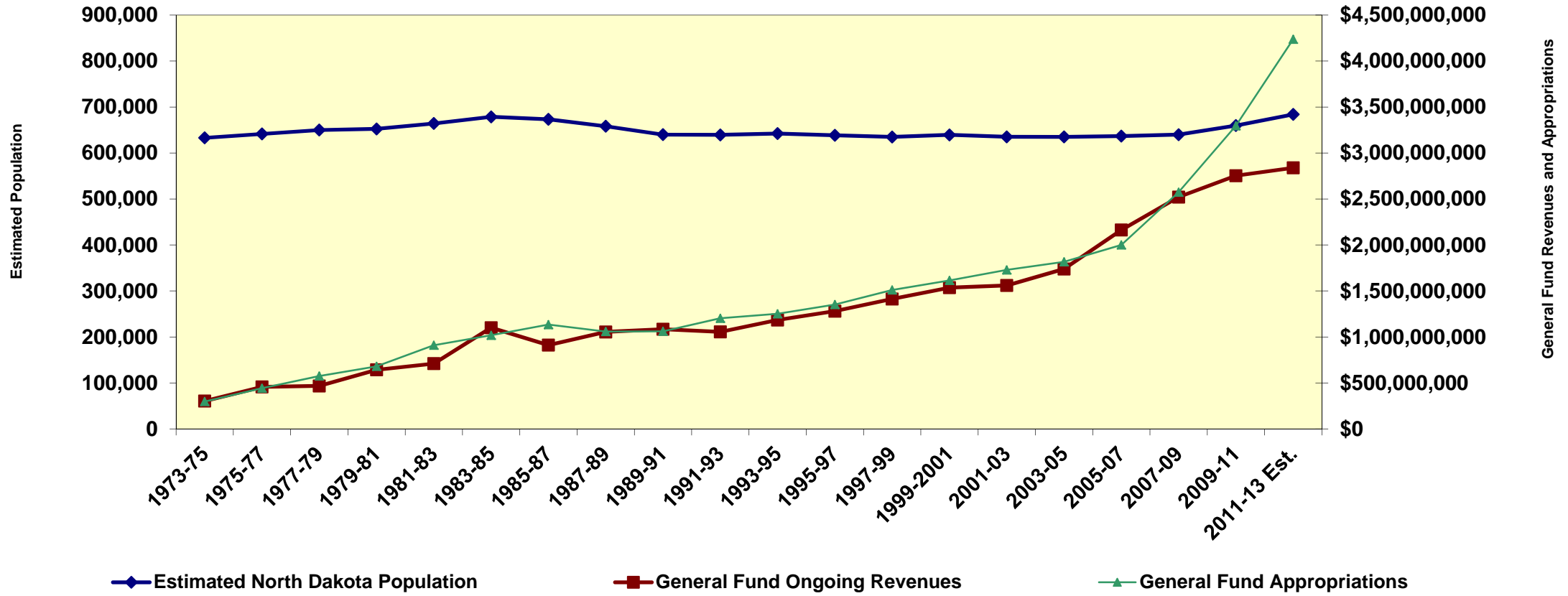
