
LEGISLATIVE DOCUMENT DRAFTING STATISTICS

This memorandum provides information on the number of bill drafts, resolution drafts, amendments, and memorandums prepared by the Legislative Council staff over the past seven legislative sessions. The information is broken down further by documents drafted for senators and documents drafted for representatives. With the exception of occasional drafting completed by division heads, the documents listed in the following table were drafted by the Legislative Council's seven attorneys and seven fiscal analysts.
