NONDRIVER PHOTO IDENTIFICATION FEES AND NONCOMMERCIAL DRIVER LICENSE FEES

In response to questions regarding fees collected by the Department of Transportation during the March 19, 2026, meeting, the department provided the following information:

Nondriver photo identification - North Dakota Century Code Section 39-06-03.1 provides the director may not charge a fee to provide a nondriver photo identification card to an eligible applicant. For purposes of voting, the department does not charge the \$8 application fee under Section 39-06-49.

Noncommercial driver license - The noncommercial driver license fee in North Dakota is \$15 every 6 years, and the schedule below provides information on the fees in other selected states.

State	Fee
Colorado	\$30.87 every 5 years
Iowa	\$4 per year every 8 years
Illinois	\$30 every 4 years
Minnesota	\$30 every 4 years plus a \$16 new application fee
Montana	\$5 per year for a standard identification valid for 12 years and a REAL identification fee of \$25 valid for 8 years
South Dakota	\$38 every 5 years
Wisconsin	\$34 every 8 years
Wyoming	\$45 initial license fee and \$35 renewal fee every 5 years
