

EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AND RURAL FIRE DISTRICT FUNDING

This memorandum provides information regarding state and local funding provided for emergency medical services (EMS) and rural fire districts.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES FUNDING Property Tax Levies for Emergency Medical Services

North Dakota Century Code Section 23-27-04.7 requires the board of county commissioners of every county to conduct an annual review of the EMS coverage within that county and to submit an annual report to the State Health Officer in a format approved by the State Department of Health. A taxing district that levies a special EMS or ambulance service levy must allocate all of the special tax levy revenue collected in a particular township to the ambulance service that serves the largest area within that township.

North Dakota Century Code references relating to property tax rates for EMS operations include:

- County - Section 57-15-06.7(23) provides that a county may levy a tax of up to 10 mills for county EMS. If the county contains a rural ambulance service district or rural fire protection district that levies for and provides EMS, the property within that district is exempt from the county tax levy.
- Township - Section 57-15-20.2(7) provides that a township may levy a tax of up to 10 mills for EMS. (No assessments were made under this section in tax year 2012.)
- City - Pursuant to Section 57-15-51, a city may impose a levy of up to 10 mills upon its taxable valuation for the purpose of subsidizing city EMS. Whenever a tax for county EMS is levied, any city levying a tax for EMS may be exempted from the county tax levy.
- Rural ambulance service districts - Pursuant to Section 57-15-26.5, a rural ambulance service district may levy a tax not exceeding 10 mills on the taxable value of property within the district.

Based on Tax Department information, EMS-related property taxes levied for tax year 2012 under Chapter 57-15, to be collected in 2013, totaled \$4.6 million. A detailed report of each property tax levy collected per county and associated mill rates for EMS is attached as [Appendix A](#). Attached as [Appendix B](#) is a summary report illustrating the total amount of property tax assessments for EMS per county in 2012.

State Funding for Emergency Medical Services

Emergency medical services funding provided by the 2013 Legislative Assembly for the 2013-15 biennium includes the following:

- \$6.4 million for **rural EMS assistance grants** - The State Department of Health will distribute \$3.2 million in rural EMS assistance grants each year of the 2013-15 biennium for a total of \$6.4 million, of which \$5,150,000 is from the general fund and \$1,250,000 is from the insurance tax distribution fund. A list of rural EMS assistance grants provided for fiscal year 2014 is attached as [Appendix C](#).
- \$940,000 for **training grants** - The State Department of Health will provide \$940,000 from the general fund for training grants during the 2013-15 biennium.
- \$7 million for **oil and gas impact grants** - Section 9 of 2013 House Bill No. 1358 appropriates \$239,299,174 from the oil and gas impact grant fund to the Board of University and School Lands for oil and gas impact grants during the 2013-15 biennium. The section also directs the Energy Infrastructure and Impact Office to include certain entities in grant recommendations made to the board, including \$7 million for grants to EMS providers for extraordinary expenditures that would mitigate negative effects of oil development impacts affecting EMS providers serving in oil-producing counties, including the need for increased EMS providers services, staff, funding, equipment, coverage, and personnel training. Through December 2013, the board has awarded grants totaling \$4.2 million to ambulance services and EMS providers. A list of Energy Infrastructure and Impact Office grants to EMS providers is attached as [Appendix D](#). In addition, the board has awarded \$2 million in multibenefit grants which benefit both EMS providers and fire districts. A list of these multibenefit grants is attached as [Appendix E](#).

Other sources

Other sources of funding for EMS include funding from a county or city general fund, countywide sales tax collections, third-party reimbursements, or other income for EMS.

RURAL FIRE DISTRICT FUNDING

Property Tax Levies for Rural Fire Protection Districts

A rural fire protection district's board of directors may determine a general fire protection program for the district and make an annual estimate of the expense for the program for purposes of tax levy. The tax levy is limited to five mills on the taxable valuation of property in the district; however, the levy may be increased by the district's board of directors to 13 mills if 20 percent of qualified electors residing in the district petition for it. In 2012, \$7,368,949 was levied for rural fire protection districts. A detailed report of each property tax levy collected per county and associated mill rates for fire protection districts is attached as [Appendix F](#). Attached as [Appendix G](#) is a summary report illustrating the total amount of property tax assessments for fire protection districts per county in 2012.

State Funding for Rural Fire Protection Districts

Insurance Premium Tax Payments to Fire Departments - The Insurance Commissioner collects an insurance premium tax at the rate of 2 percent with respect to life insurance and 1.75 percent with respect to all other lines of insurance. Insurance premium tax collections are deposited in the insurance tax distribution fund in an amount equal to legislative appropriations from the fund for the biennium, with the remainder deposited in the general fund. For the 2011-13 biennium, the Legislative Assembly appropriated \$6.2 million from the insurance tax distribution fund for insurance tax payments to fire departments. For the 2013-15 biennium, the Legislative Assembly appropriated \$14,536,386 from the fund for insurance tax payments to fire departments. The allocation to each individual fire department is made in proportion to the amount of insurance premiums received by insurance companies for certain policies on property within the city, certified rural fire protection district, or area served by the certified rural fire department to the total of those premiums for those policies in the state. The applicable policies include fire, allied lines, homeowner's multiple peril, farm owner's multiple peril, commercial multiple peril, and crop hail insurance. In November 2013, payments totaling \$7,268,193 were made to fire departments. This represents an increase of \$4,168,193--or 134.5 percent--compared to the total payments of \$3,100,000 made in September 2012. Payment information for each fire department may be viewed in [Appendix H](#).

Board of University and School Lands Grants - Section 9 of 2013 House Bill No. 1358 appropriates \$239,299,174 to the Board of University and School Lands for oil and gas impact grants during the 2013-15 biennium. Through March 2014, the board has awarded grants totaling nearly \$6 million to fire protection districts. A list of Energy Infrastructure and Impact Office grants to fire protection districts is attached as [Appendix I](#). In addition, the board has awarded \$2 million in multibenefit grants which benefit EMS providers and fire districts. A list of these multibenefit grants is attached as [Appendix E](#).

Other Funding Sources

Rural Fire Departments Reimbursement for Fire Protection Service - Rural fire departments may enter contracts with state and local government agencies to provide fire protection service or fire protection cooperation. Reimbursement for this fire protection must be a reasonable annual fee based on the agency's acreage within the fire district, and the fee may not be greater than if the property had been subject to property tax levies. In some instances, reimbursement on these contracts is paid not by cash but in exchange for allowing a rural fire department use of city buildings and sometimes paying any associated utilities. The State Fire Marshal's office does not have information on the number of rural fire departments entering these types of agreements; therefore, any associated funding is not available.
