

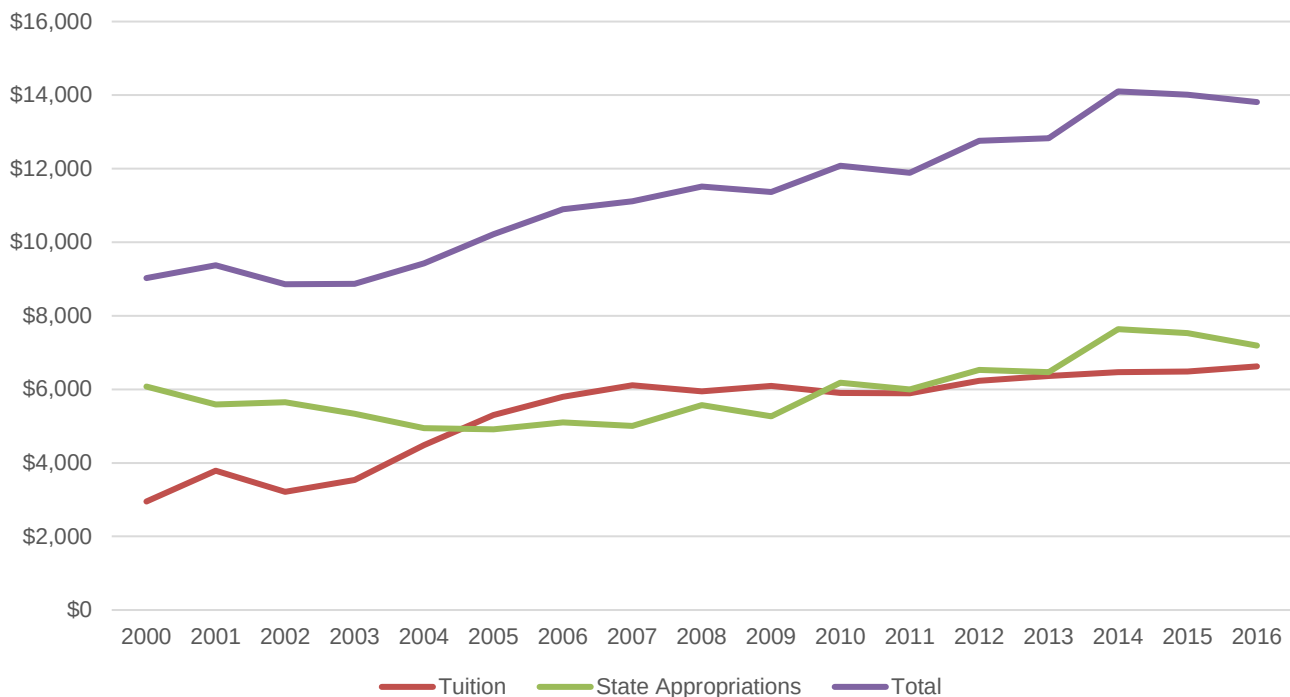
## TUITION AND STATE APPROPRIATIONS DATA

This memorandum provides information regarding higher education revenues per full-time equivalent (FTE) student. The information is derived from State Higher Education Executive Officers Association data. The following table details information regarding North Dakota higher education funding compared to national averages.
