## FULL NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT AND AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Board of Medicine will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments and a new chapter to N.D. Admin. Code title 50, at 9:00 a.m. on September 6, 2024, at the Board's Conference Room, located at 4204 Boulder Ridge Rd, Suite 220, Bismarck, ND 58503. The purpose of the proposed amendments is to provide clarification on grounds for discipline, recognize additional exceptions for licensure for certain telemedicine encounters, clarify acceptable education of physician assistants, and implement rules on genetic counselors. The proposed amendments implement definitions for various grounds of discipline outlined in law (article 50-01.1), telemedicine exceptions to licensure (article 50-02-15), clarification of physician assistant education for licensure (article 50-03-01-02), and implementation of genetic counseling rules (chapter 50-07).

The proposed amendments are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.
