**FULL NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT AND AMEND
ADMINISTRATIVE RULES**

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Highway Patrol will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Admin. Code chapter 38-04-01 at 10:00 a.m. on June 29, 2026, at the Law Enforcement Training Academy, 1320 Schafer Street, Bismarck, ND. The purpose of the proposed amendment to the rules is to modify the qualifications for intrastate commercial motor vehicle drivers.

The proposed rule amendment is not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.

The proposed rules may be reviewed at the office of the North Dakota Highway Patrol, 600 E Blvd Ave, Dept 504, Bismarck, ND, 58505.
