NOTICE OF INTENT TO  
AMEND, ADOPT, AND REPEAL ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to ND Admin. Code 87-01 through 87-05, adoption of 87-07, and repeal of 87-06 at 5:30pm on October 6, 2025, at the DoubleTree by Hilton, 825 E. Beaton Drive, West Fargo, ND 58078. The purpose of the proposed amendments and rule is to implement statutory changes to ND Century Code 43-29. The proposed amendments and rule are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.

The proposed rulemaking implements bill number SB2129, enacted during the most recent legislative session, concerning the practice of veterinary medicine and veterinary technology.

The proposed rules may be reviewed at the office of the North Dakota Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners, PO Box 328, Lisbon, ND 58054.
