NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota State Seed Department will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Admin. Code title 74, chapter 74-04-01 (Organization of Commission); chapter 74-02-01 (Seed Representation and Labeling); chapter 74-03-01 (General Seed Certification Requirements); chapter 74-03-12.1 (Specific Crop Requirements-Field Peas) and chapter 74-04-01 (Seed Potato Certification Standards) at 10:00 am on May 30th, 2024 at the North Dakota State Seed Department, 1313 18th St. N., Fargo, ND 58105. The purpose of the proposed amendments is to update and revise outdated rules in administrative code. The proposed amendment is not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.
